CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Garfield Economic Impact Award

Research!America and the University of Chicago Medical Center are proud to announce a call for nominations for the eighth annual Garfield Economic Impact Award. Established in 2002, the award annually recognizes outstanding research demonstrating how medical and health research impacts the economy. Founding support for the Garfield Award was provided by the Eugene Garfield Foundation. In 2008, the University of Chicago Medical Center's sponsorship of the award increased the honorarium to \$10,000, extending its impact and prominence. The 2009 Garfield Award will be presented on October 13, 2009 at the United States Chamber of Commerce in Washington, DC.

The Award Committee will consider nominations received by the close of business
May 29, 2009.

Nominations should include:

- 1) A copy of the publication or thesis.
- 2) A 200-word statement summarizing the reasons the work should be recognized—particularly describing how the work illustrates the economic benefits of medical and health research.
- 3) To be considered, the work must have been published or accepted for publication between January 1, 2003 and December 31, 2008.
- 4) To encourage growth of the field, the Garfield Award committee urges nomination of individuals early in their career.
- 5) Self-nominations are welcome.
