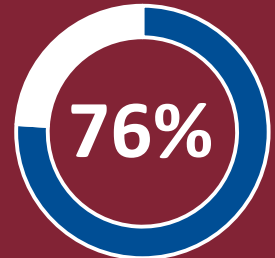

Research in the Treasure State

University of Chicago, Rocky Mountain Laboratories, Montana State University (MSU), Hamilton, MT
Rocky Mountain Laboratories collaborated with MSU and University of Chicago to investigate *Staphylococcus aureus* (*S. aureus*). In its methicillin-resistant form (MRSA), this bacteria accounts for over 9,000 deaths in the U.S. annually. The researchers discovered that *S. aureus* secretes molecules that interfere with the ability of immune cells to bind, which plays a role in the body's inability to fight this infection.

University of Montana, Missoula, MT

National Science Foundation (NSF)-funded researchers at the University of Montana are studying new uses of mass spectrometry for the diagnosis of protein-related diseases, such as Alzheimer's disease.

Nabriva Therapeutics, Butte, MT

Community-acquired bacterial pneumonia is a major public health threat for the elderly and immune compromised individuals. Nabriva Therapeutics is conducting phase III clinical trials to test the safety and efficacy of a new treatment for this costly and potentially deadly form of pneumonia.
