Research in the Great Lakes State

Pfizer, Detroit, MI

Sickle cell anemia (SCA), a group of inherited blood disorders found predominantly among people of African descent, can cause both chronic and acute pain, organ damage and premature death. Pfizer is conducting phase III clinical trials testing the safety and efficacy of a new drug to treat patients hospitalized due to "pain crises," SCA-related episodes of debilitating pain.

University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, MI

Every year at least 100,000 Americans die from complications following a major surgery. The Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) is funding research at the University of Michigan to pinpoint the best strategies for quickly recognizing the presence of a post-surgery complication and properly diagnosing and treating it.

Van Andel Research Institute (VARI) and Cedars-Sinai, Grand Rapids, MI

VARI, in collaboration with Cedars-Sinai, has received funding from the National Cancer Institute (NCI) to explore whether changes in the expression levels of genes can illuminate how cancer begins and progresses.
