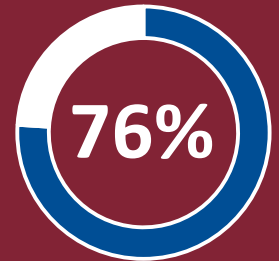


Total Direct and Indirect

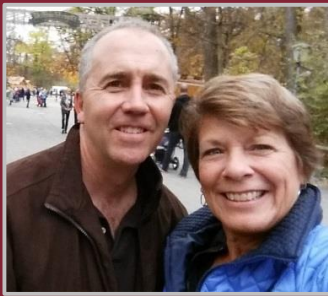

Purdue University, West Lafayette, IN

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has awarded Purdue a research grant to work closely with local counties to develop and implement new strategies to combat the high incidence of adult obesity, which affects more than one-third of Americans and increases the risk for heart disease, stroke and certain types of cancer.

Eli Lilly, Indianapolis, IN

Eli Lilly is conducting a phase III clinical trial to determine the efficacy of a new drug in improving the cognitive function of patients in the beginning stages of Alzheimer's disease.

Purdue University, West Lafayette, IN

Researchers at Purdue have been awarded funding from the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) to research the causes of poor outcomes in medication therapy management in order to improve electronic clinical decision-making support.
