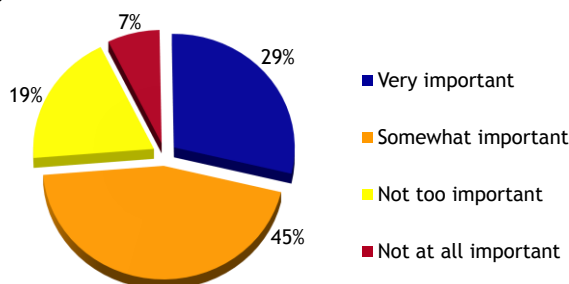

## Georgians Think Global Health Research is Important to Economy

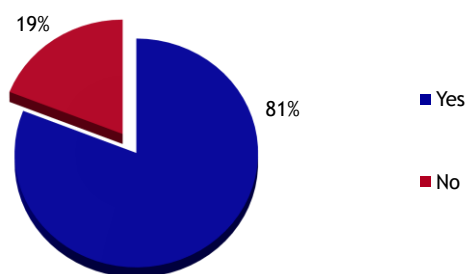
In terms of jobs and incomes, how important do you think spending money on research to improve health globally is to the economy of Georgia?

## Georgians Think They Should Be Concerned About Global Health

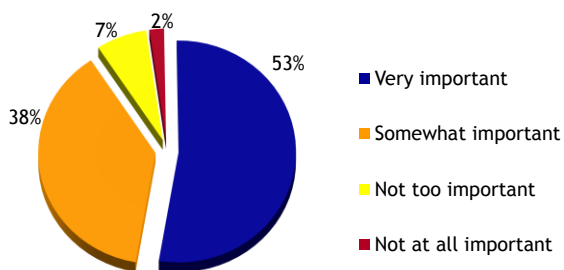
When you hear the term global health, do you think it is an issue about which Georgia residents should be concerned?

## Most Say CDC is Important to Georgia's Economy

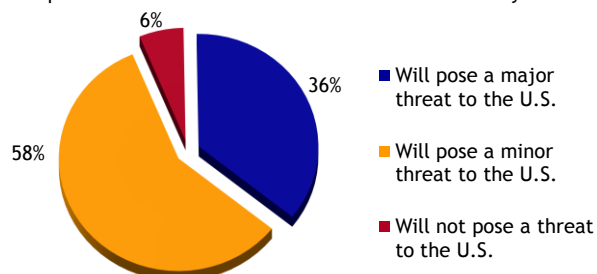
In terms of jobs and incomes, how important do you think the CDC is to the economy of Georgia? Would you say it is...

## Majority of Georgians Think Global Diseases Are Threat to U.S.

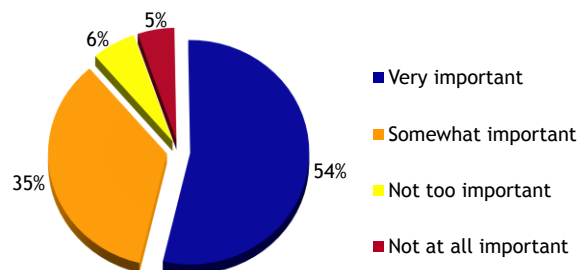

## Important for Government to Play a Role in Prevention Research

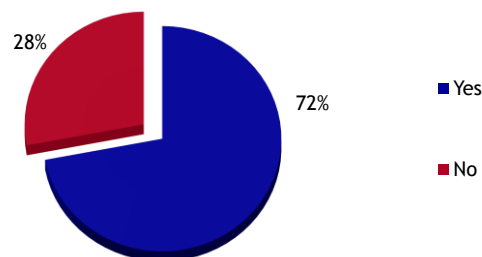
How important is it that the federal government plays a role in research for prevention and wellness?

## Georgians Say Americans Should Worry About Global Diseases

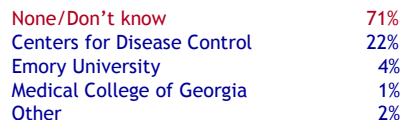
Should Americans worry about diseases - like malaria, dengue fever, and cholera - that mostly affect poorer countries?

## Most Don't Know Who Conducts Global Health Research in Georgia

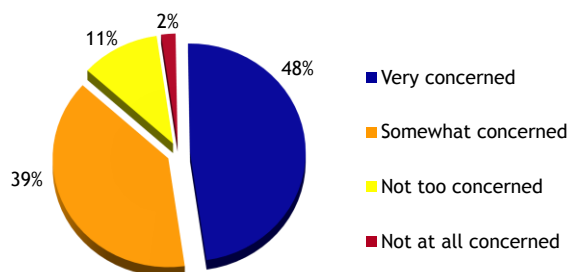
Do you know of any institutions, companies or organizations in Georgia where global health research is conducted? (% first volunteered responses)

## Georgians Concerned About Disease Exposure for Overseas Troops

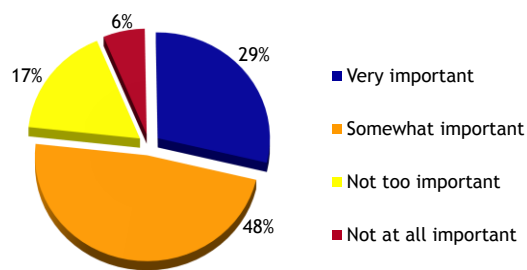
How concerned are you that our troops overseas are exposed to diseases that disproportionately affect poorer countries?
