






High Confidence in Medical and Scientific Communities

{% saying great deal or some}






U.S. Priorities

In terms of U.S. priorities, would you say each of the following is very important, somewhat important, not very important, or not at all important?




U.S. Health Priorities

Commitment to Research Should Be Higher


As we look for ways to manage health care costs in our country, do you think that our commitment to health-related research should be higher, lower, or about the same as it is now?





U.S. Should Be Global Leader in Research


How important do you think it is that the U.S. is a global leader in medical, health and scientific research?





U.S. Performance in Science and Math Education


Do you think the U.S. is performing well or performing poorly compared to other nations in terms of science and math education?





Encouraging Youth to Pursue Science Careers Is a Priority


How important is it for Hispanic families to encourage their children to go into the fields of medical, health, and scientific research?





Expanding Research Career Opportunities Important for Hispanic Youths


How important is it for the U.S. to create more opportunities for Hispanic youths to pursue careers in science and research?





Hispanics Want More Spent on Medical and Health Research


Currently, less than 6 cents out of each health dollar spent in the U.S. goes for research to improve health. How many cents out of each health dollar do you think we SHOULD spend?





Hispanics Willing to Pay More Taxes for Medical Research


Would you be willing to pay \$1 per week more in taxes if you were certain that all the money would be spent for additional medical research, or not?





Important to Understand Hispanic Culture's Influence on Health




Factors Affecting Health Care Quality

Environmental Health Research Very Important


