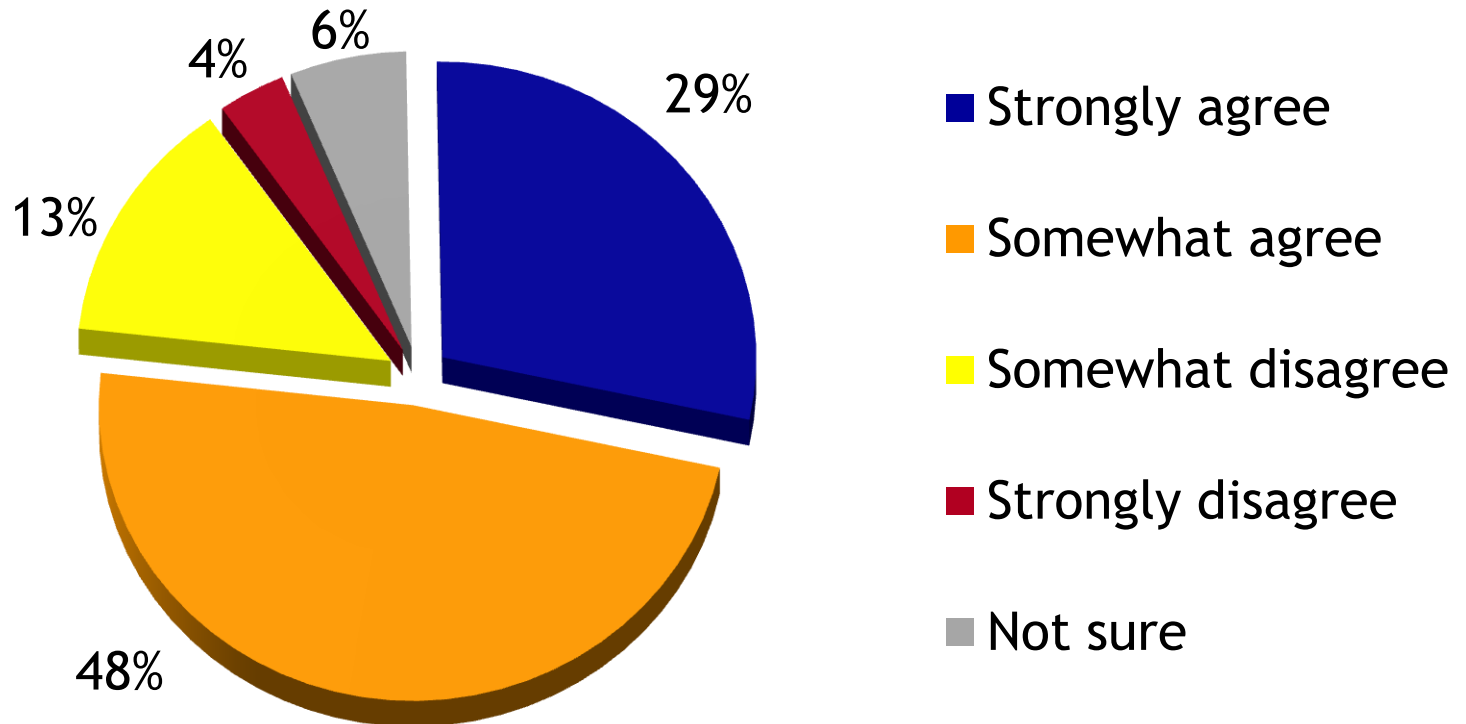
Results of a New National Public Opinion Poll

Americans: U.S. Losing Its Competitive Edge in Innovation

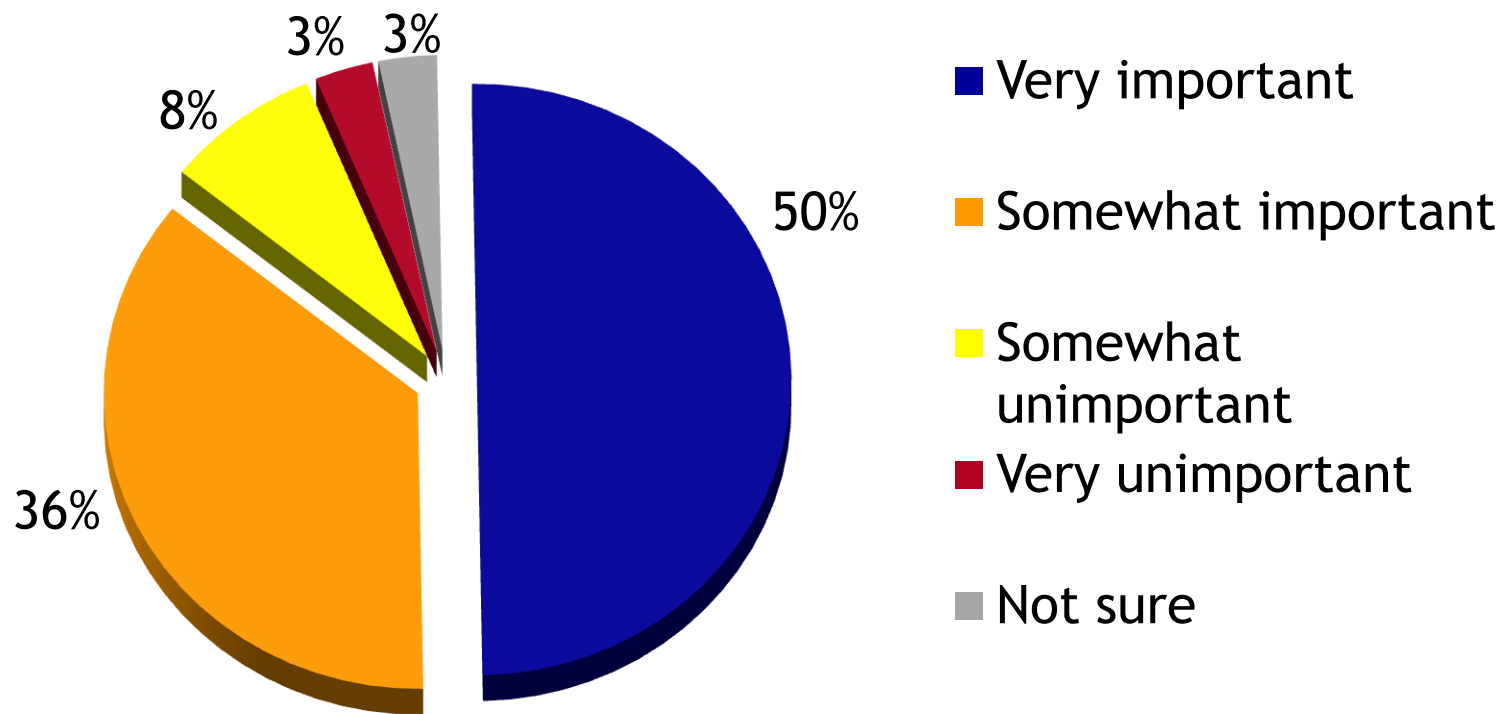
Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? “The U.S. is losing its global competitive edge in science, technology and innovation.”

Investing in Health Research Important to Job Creation, Recovery

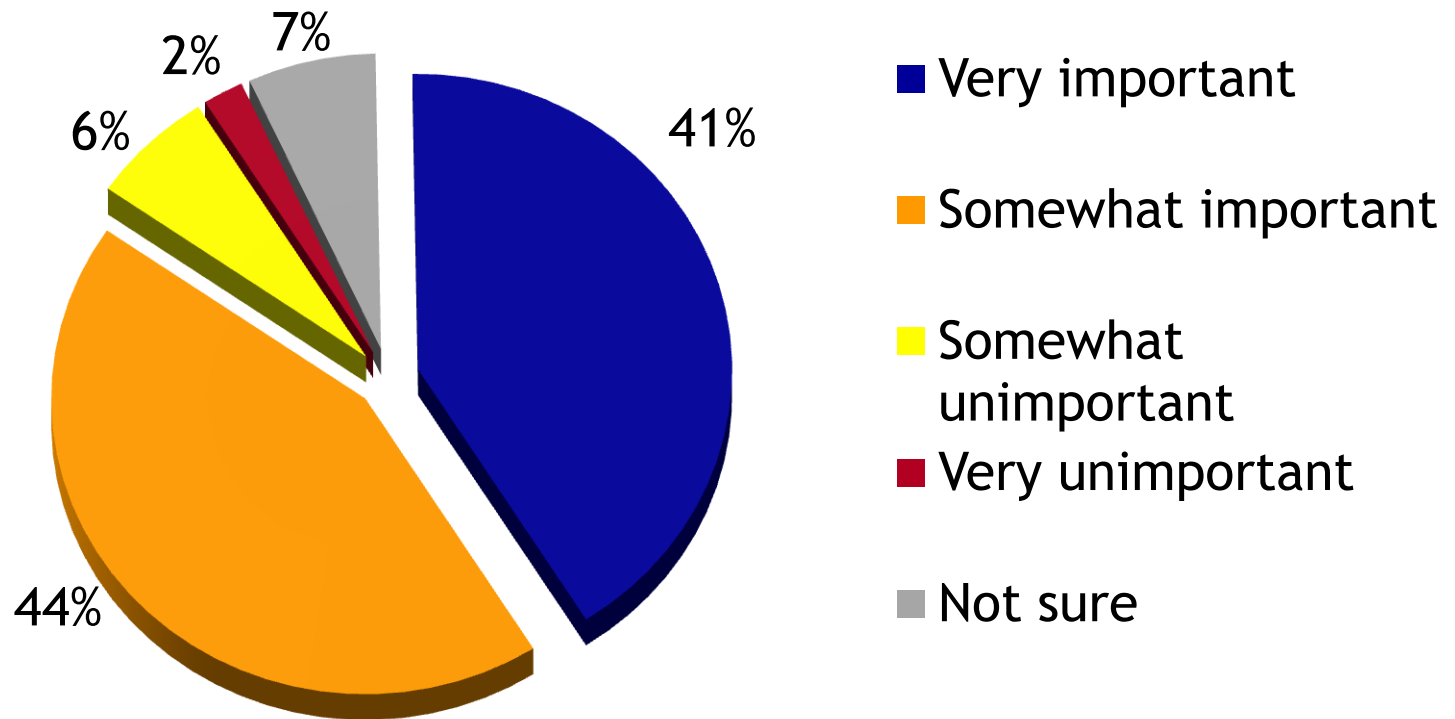
How important is investing in health research to job creation and economic recovery?

How important do you think research and innovation is to your state's economy?

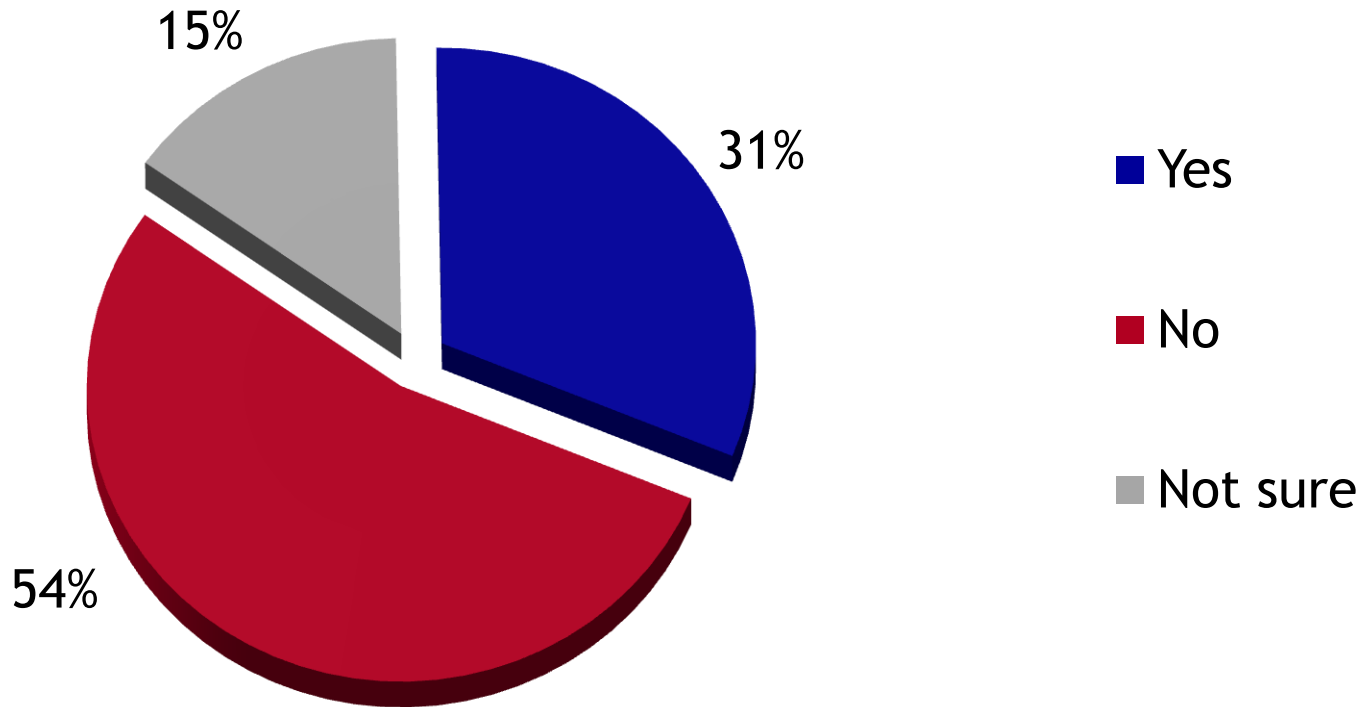

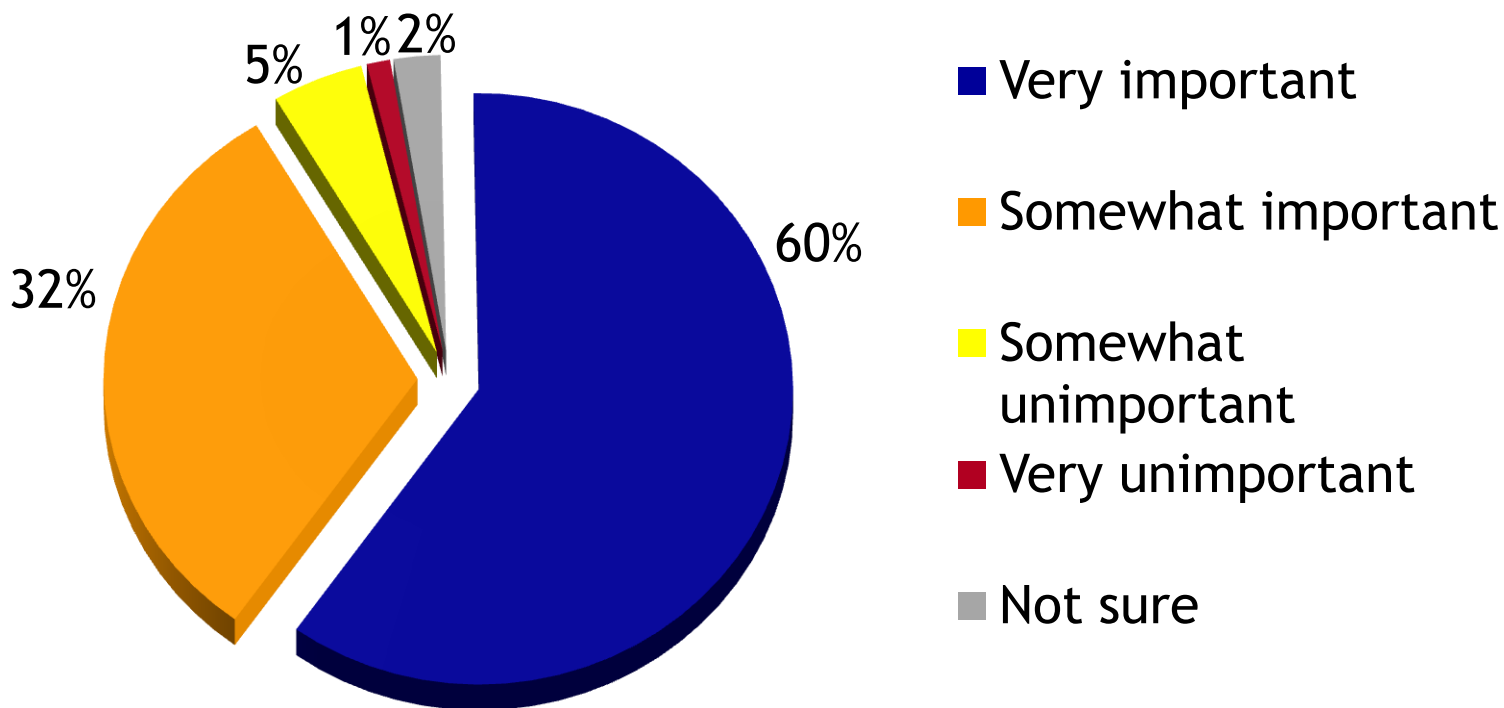
Do you believe the United States has the best health care system in the world?

Majority Say Health Care Research is Important

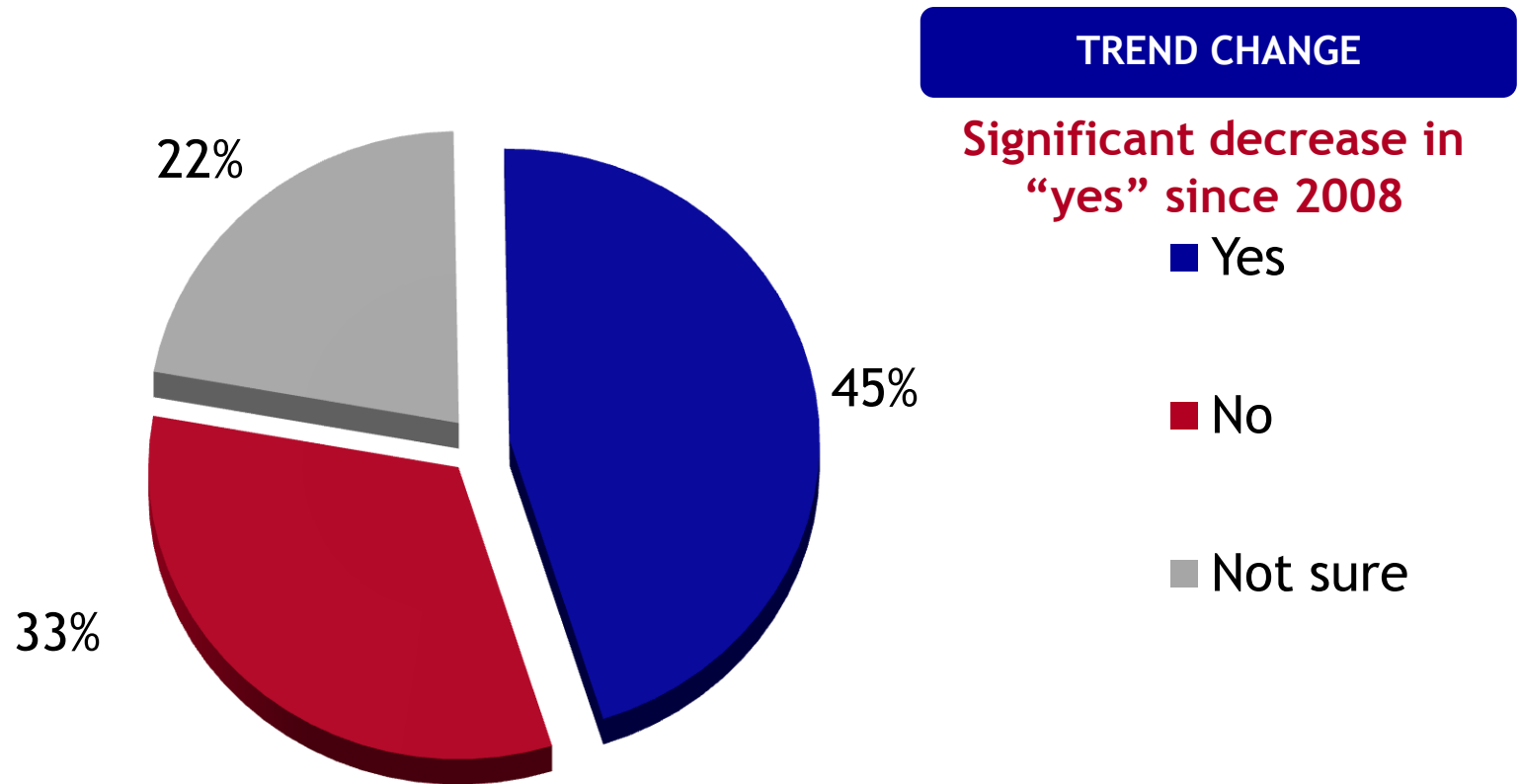
How important is it that our nation support research that focuses on how well the health care system is functioning?

Do you believe the health care services you personally receive are based on the best and most recent research available?

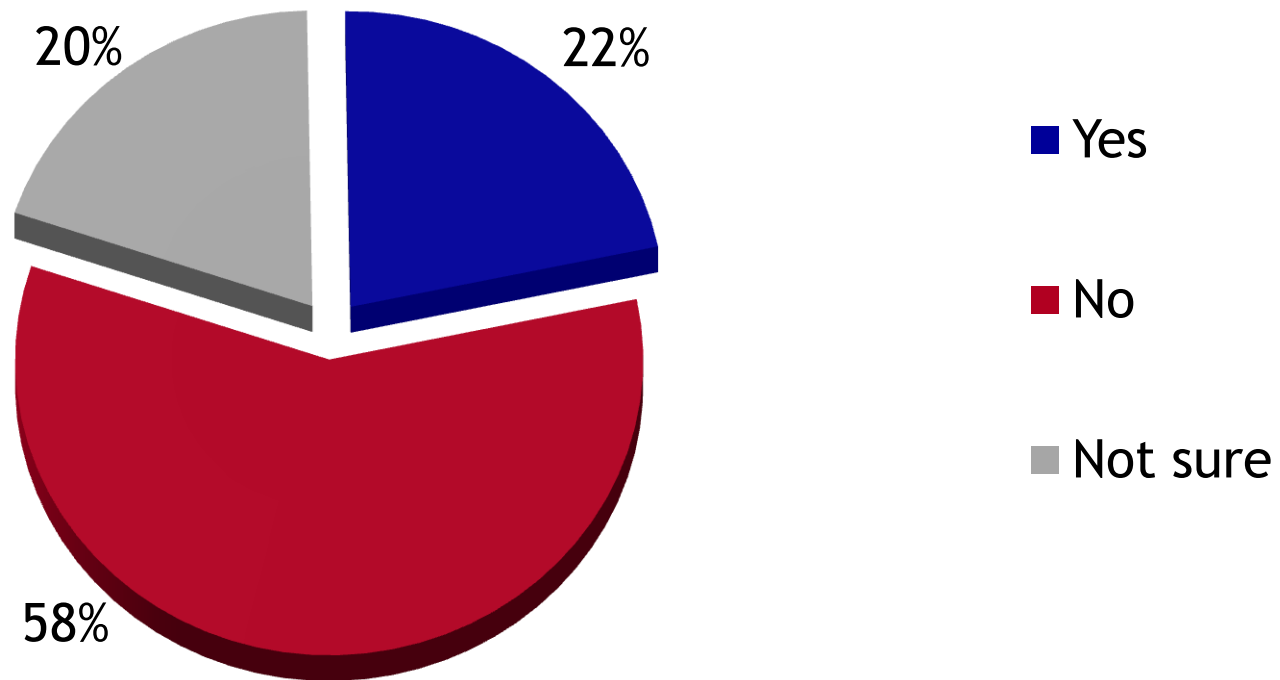

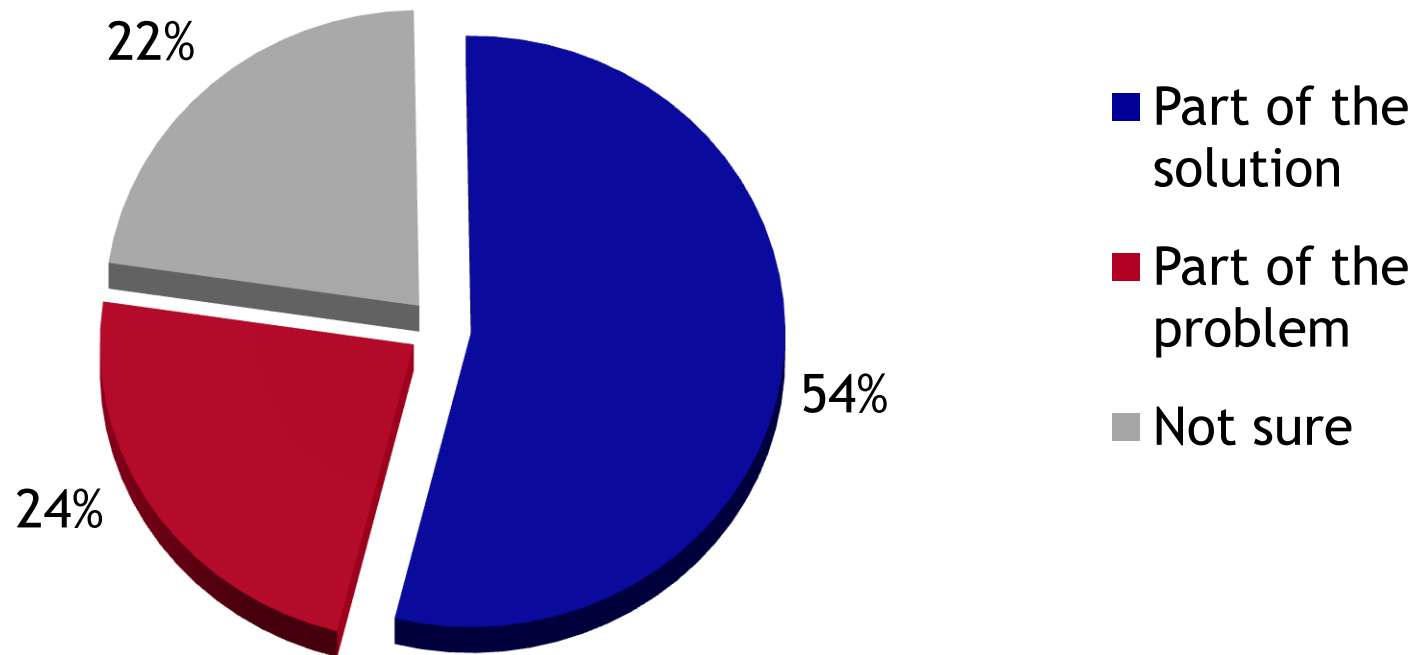
Do you believe that we are making enough progress in medical research in the U.S.?

Research is Part of the Solution to Rising Health Care Costs

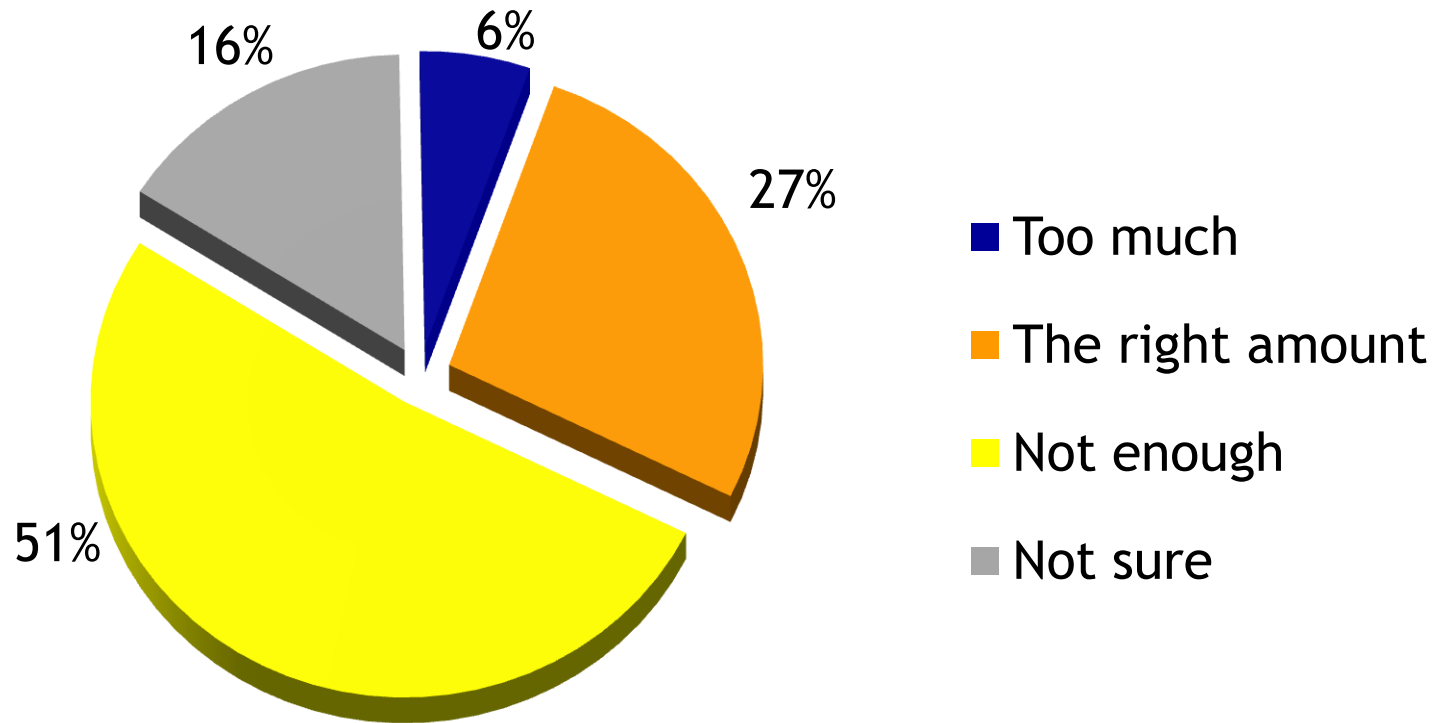
When it comes to rising health care costs, would you say research to improve health is part of the problem or part of the solution?

U.S. is Not Spending Enough of the Health Dollar on Research

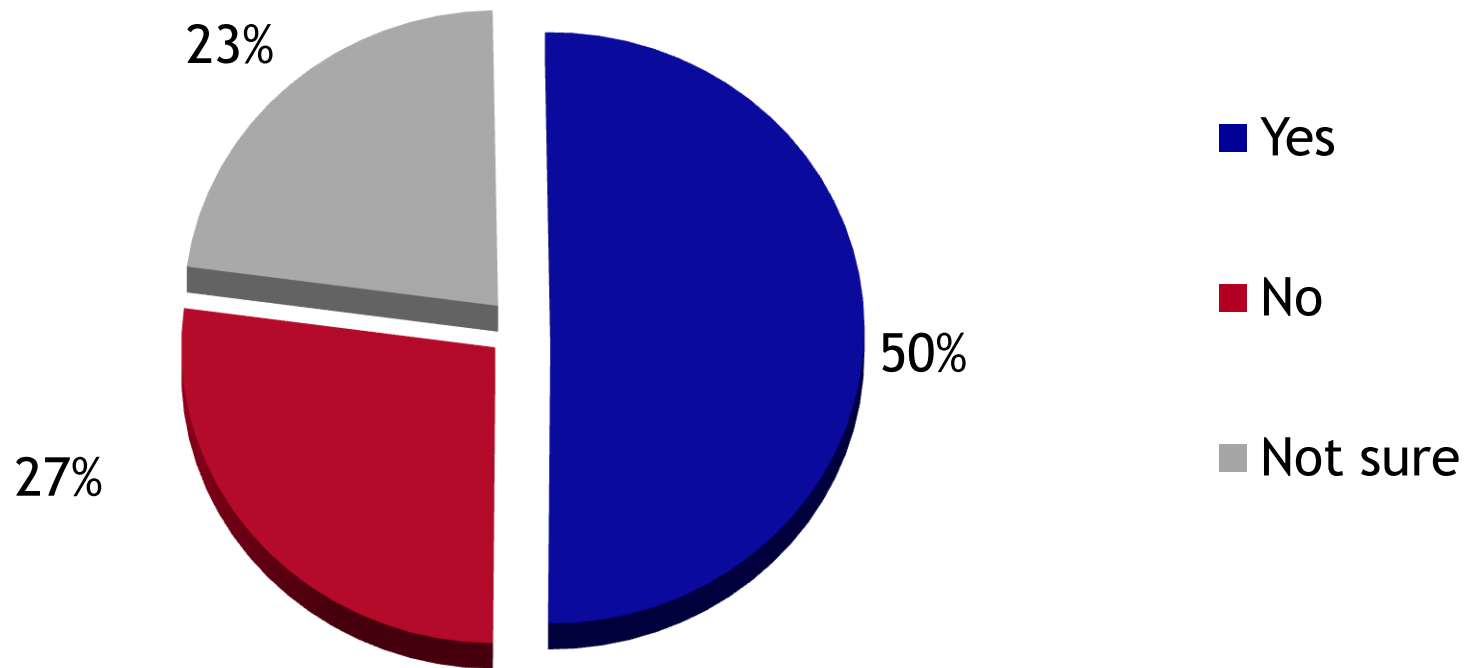

Half of Americans Willing to Pay Tax for Research

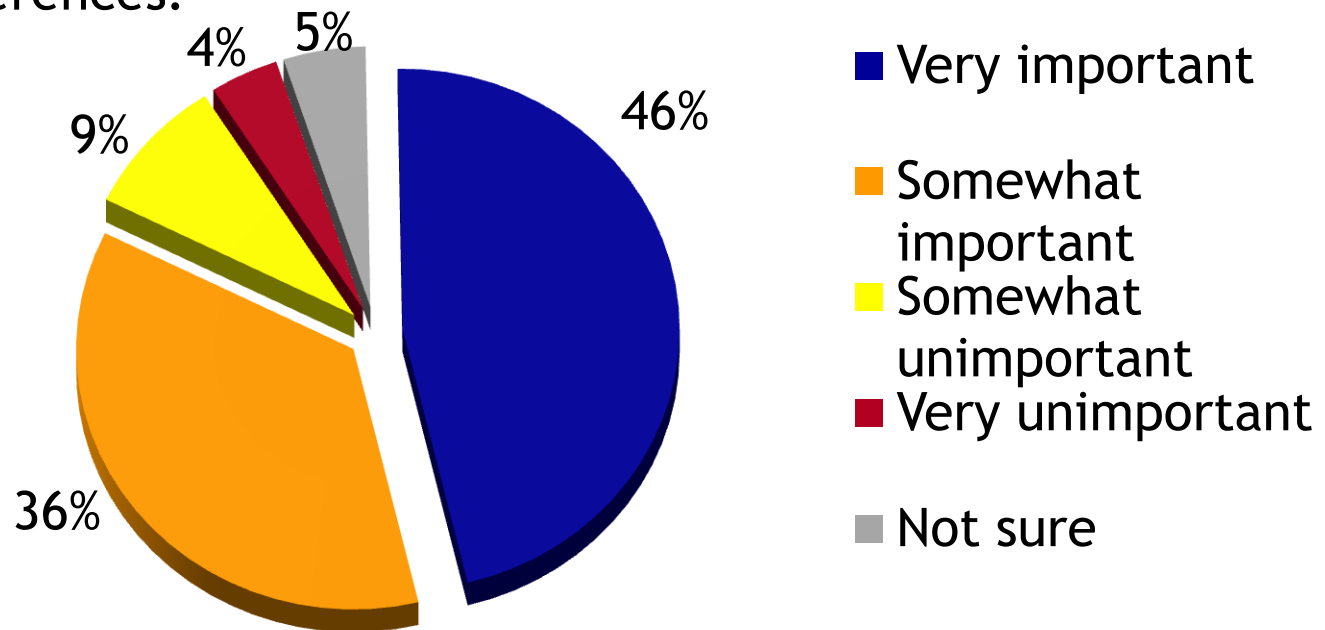
Would you be willing to pay \$1 per week more in taxes if you were certain that all of the money would be spent for additional medical research?

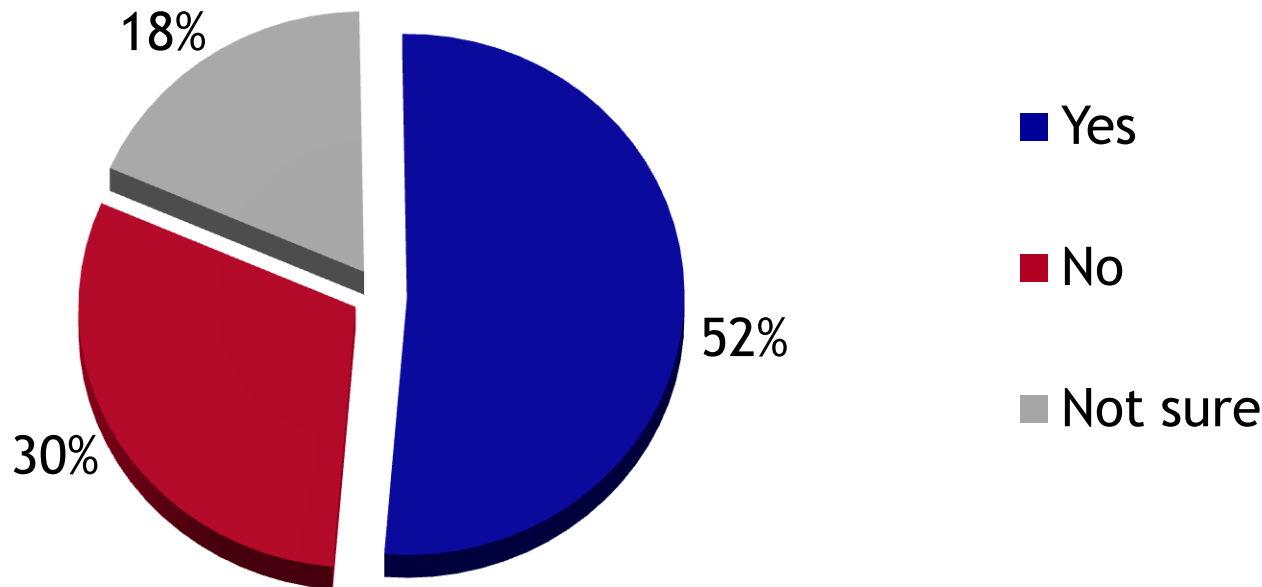

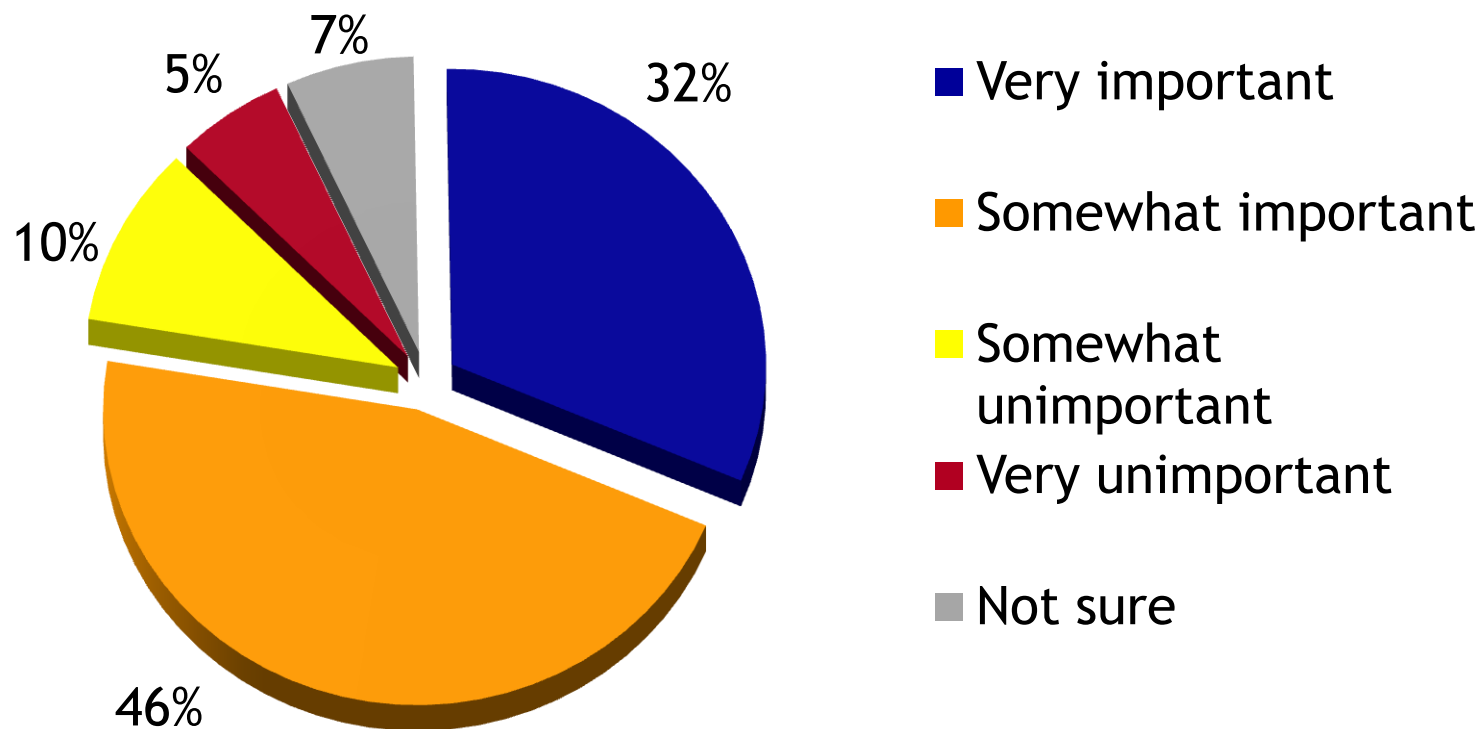

Important for the U.S. to Support Global Health Research

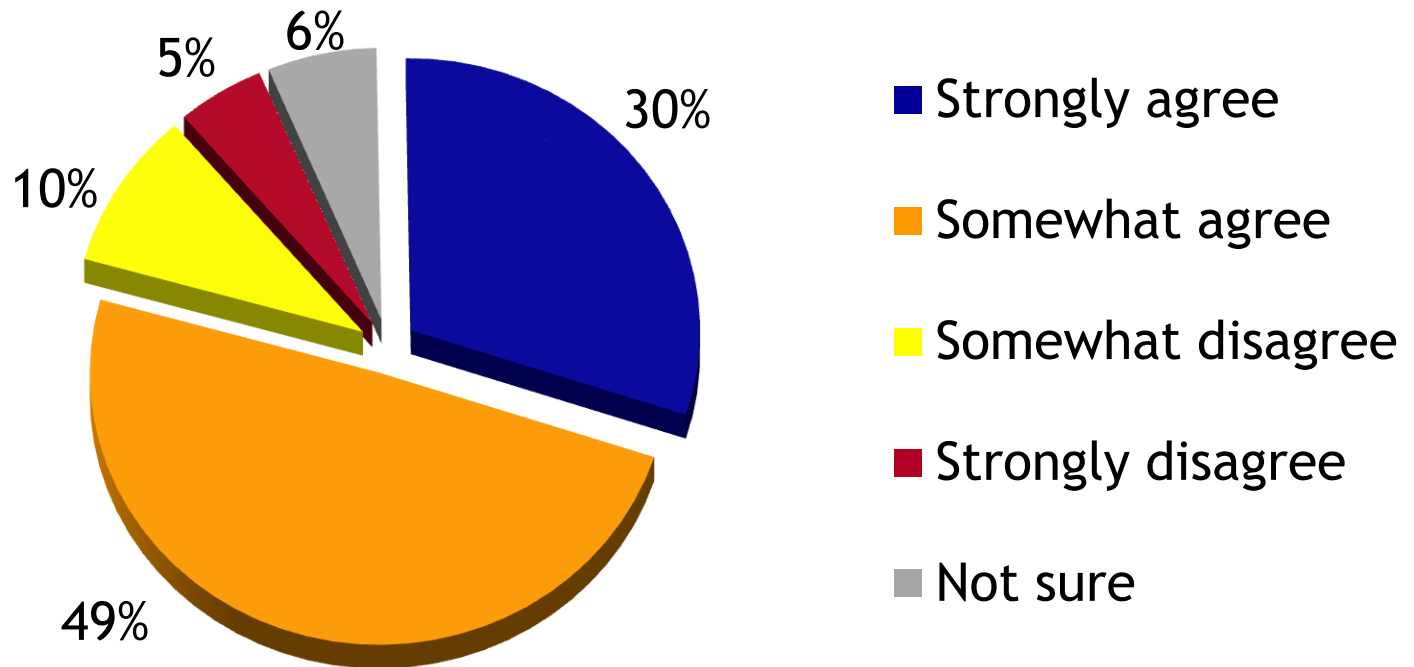
How important would you say it is that the U.S. work to improve health globally through research and innovation?

Most Agree that Basic Research is Necessary

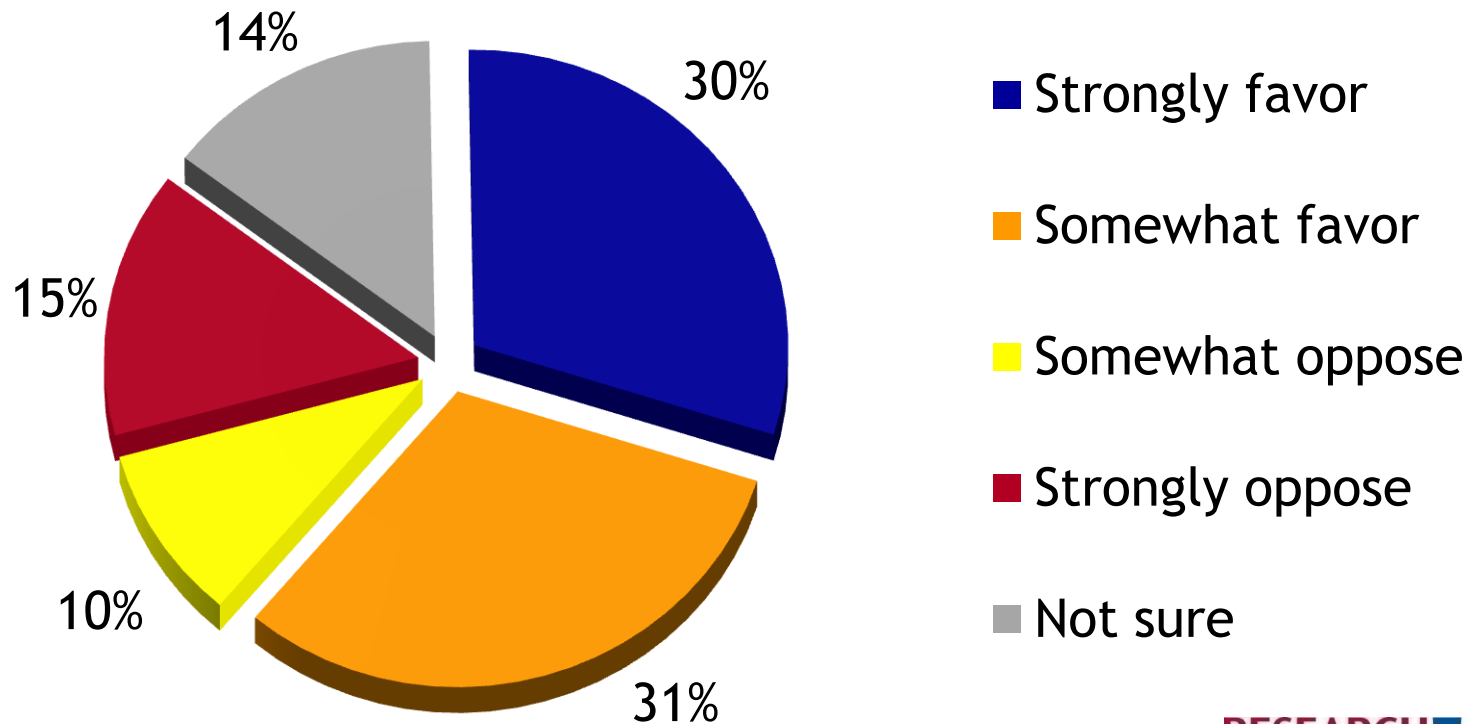

Do you favor or oppose expanding federal funding for research using embryonic stem cells?

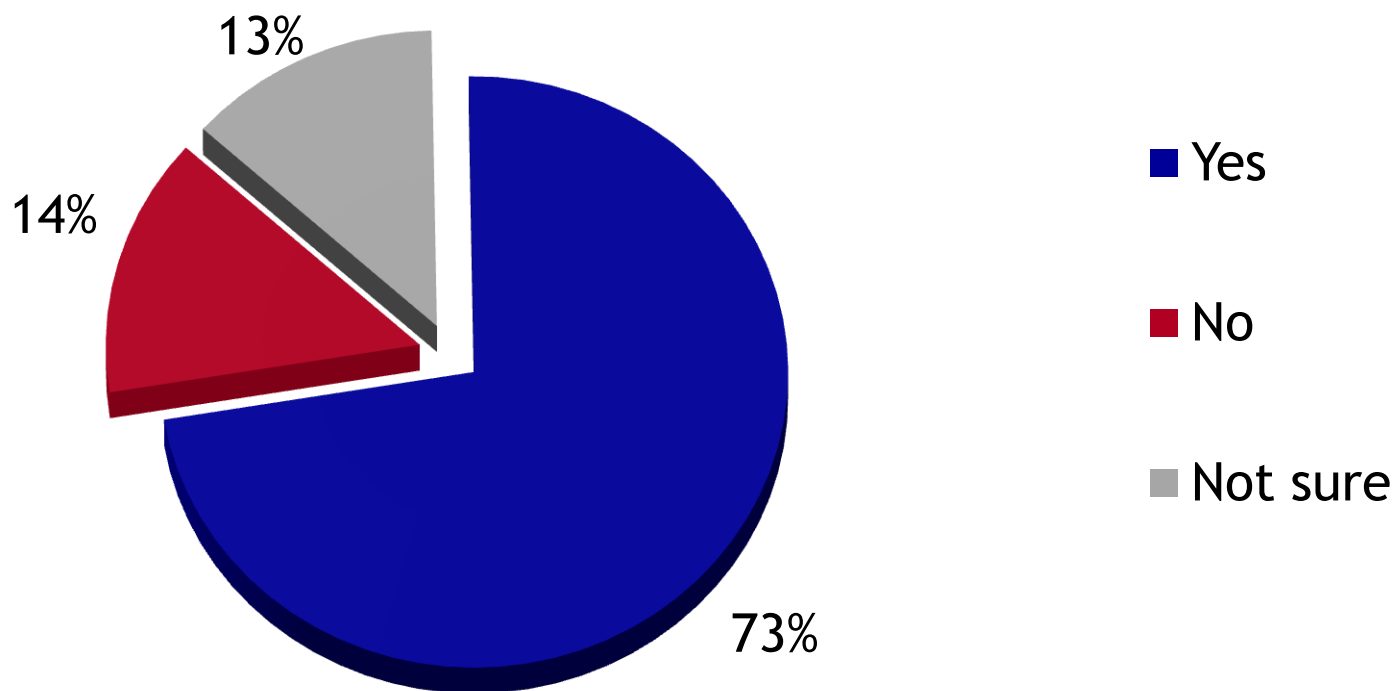

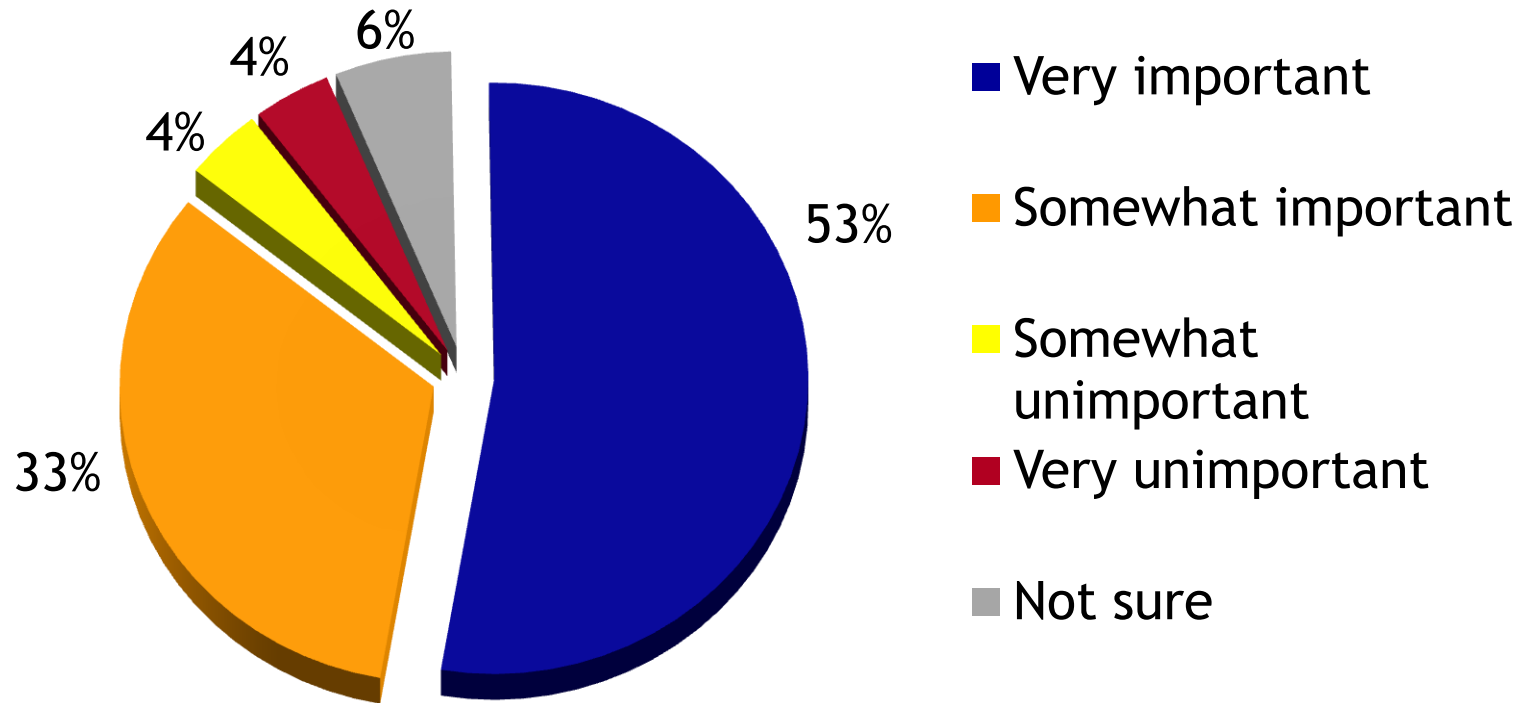
Do you believe the federal government should place more emphasis on increasing the number of young Americans who pursue careers in science, technology, engineering and mathematics?

Important to Increase Funding for CDC

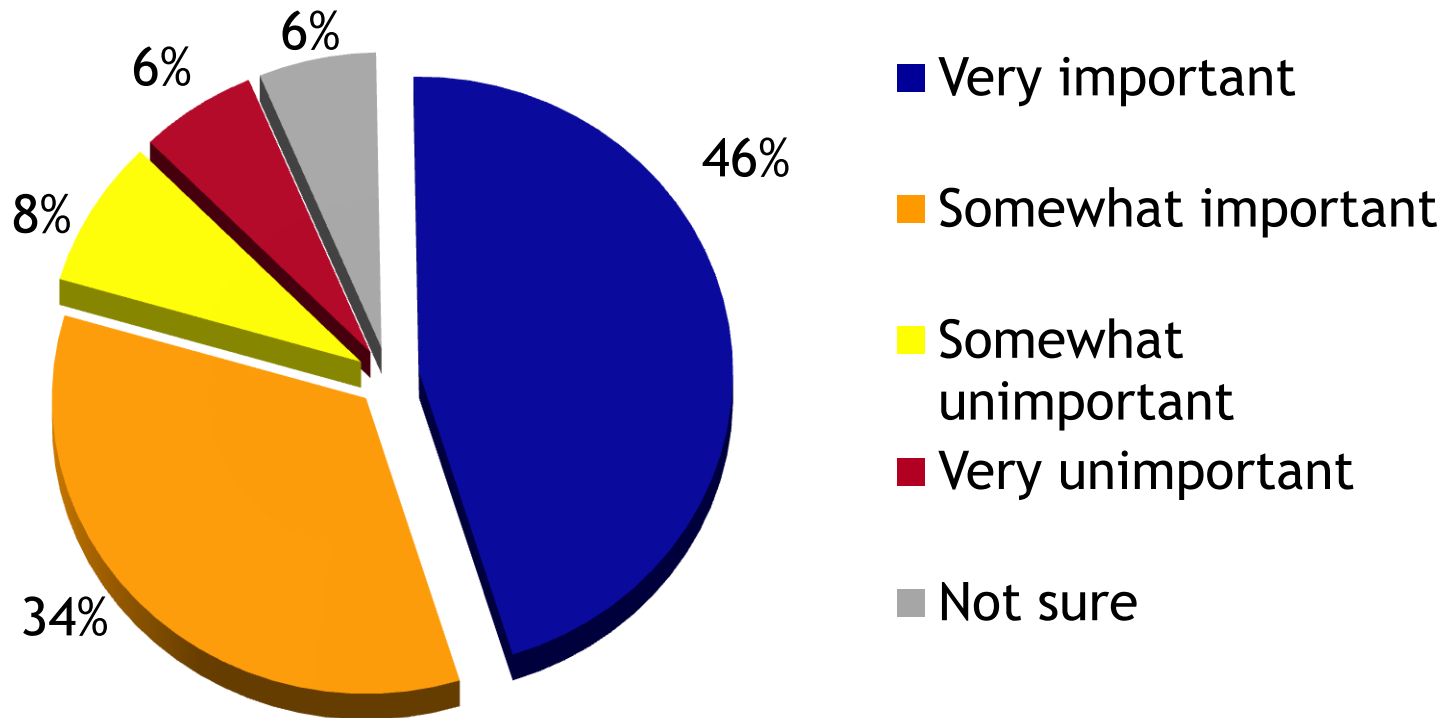
How important is it to increase funding for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention?

Important to Increase Funding for FDA

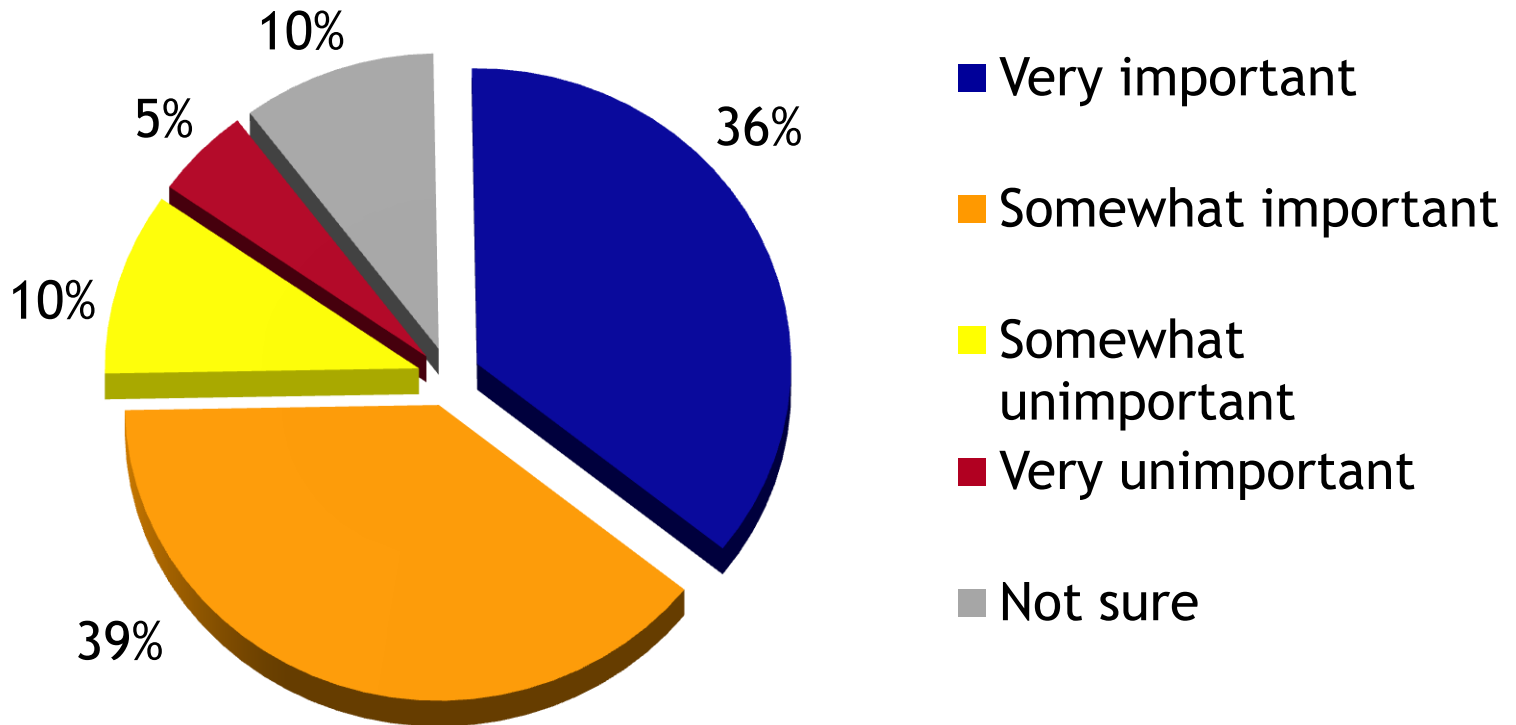
How important is it to increase funding for the Food and Drug Administration?

Important to Increase Funding for NIH

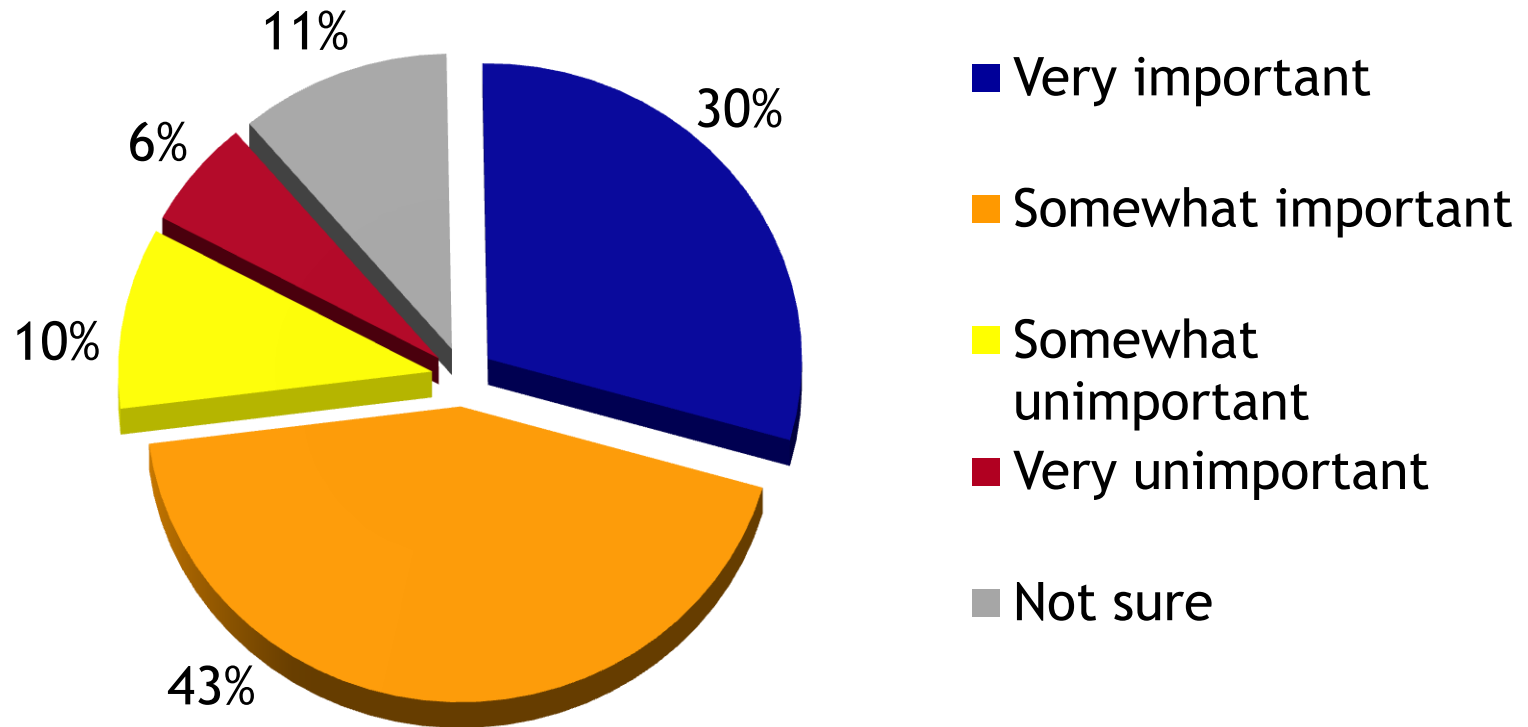
How important is it to increase funding for the National Institutes of Health?

Important to Increase Funding for NSF

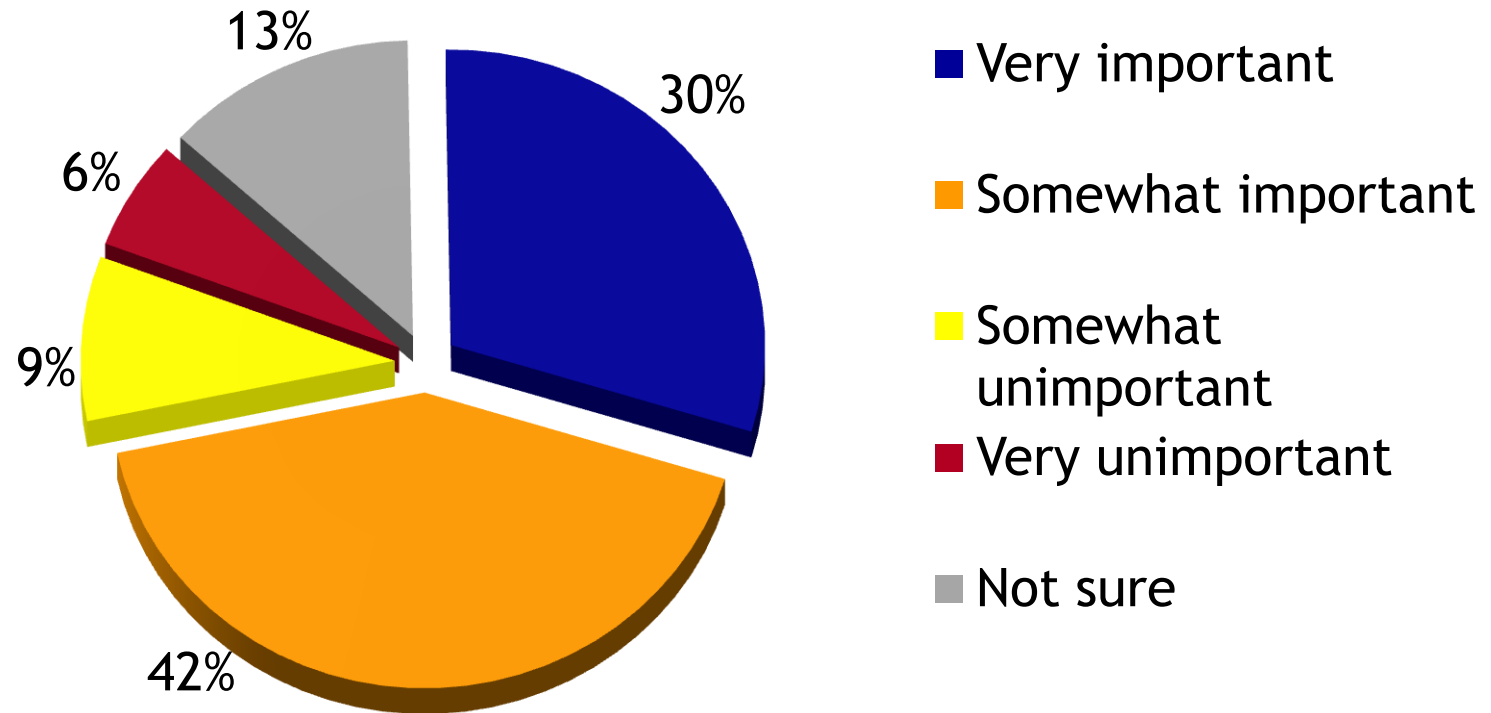
How important is it to increase funding for the National Science Foundation?

Important to Increase Funding for AHRQ

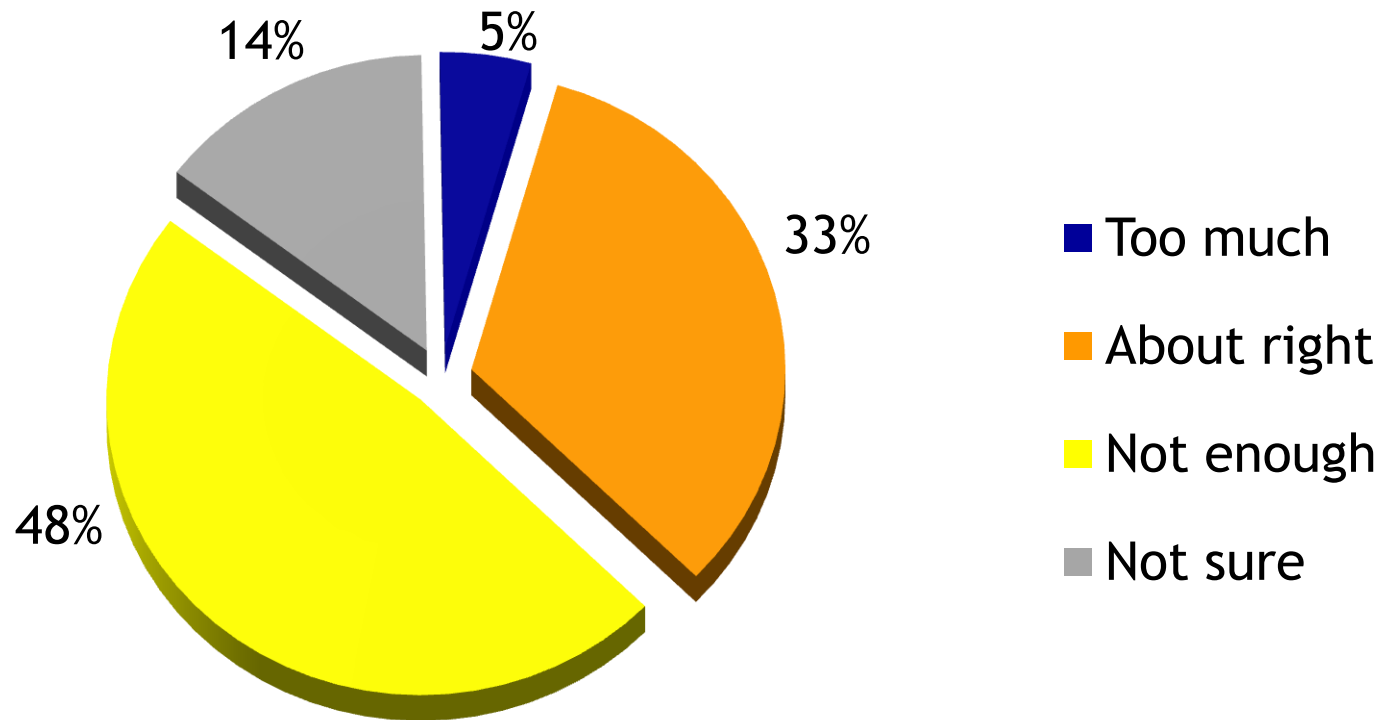
How important is it to increase funding for the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality?

Americans: More Investment Needed for Military Veterans

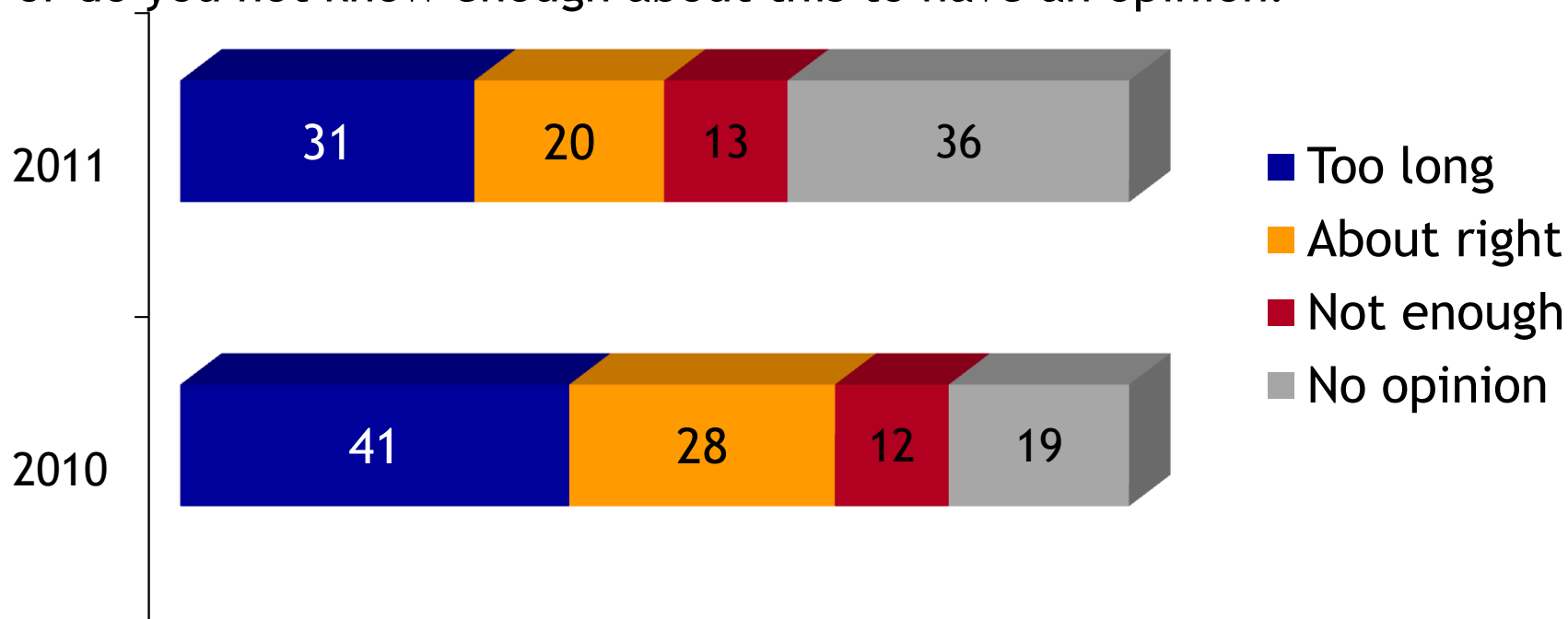
Would you say government investment in health research for the benefit of military veterans and service members is ...

Opinions Mixed on Amount of Time for FDA Approval

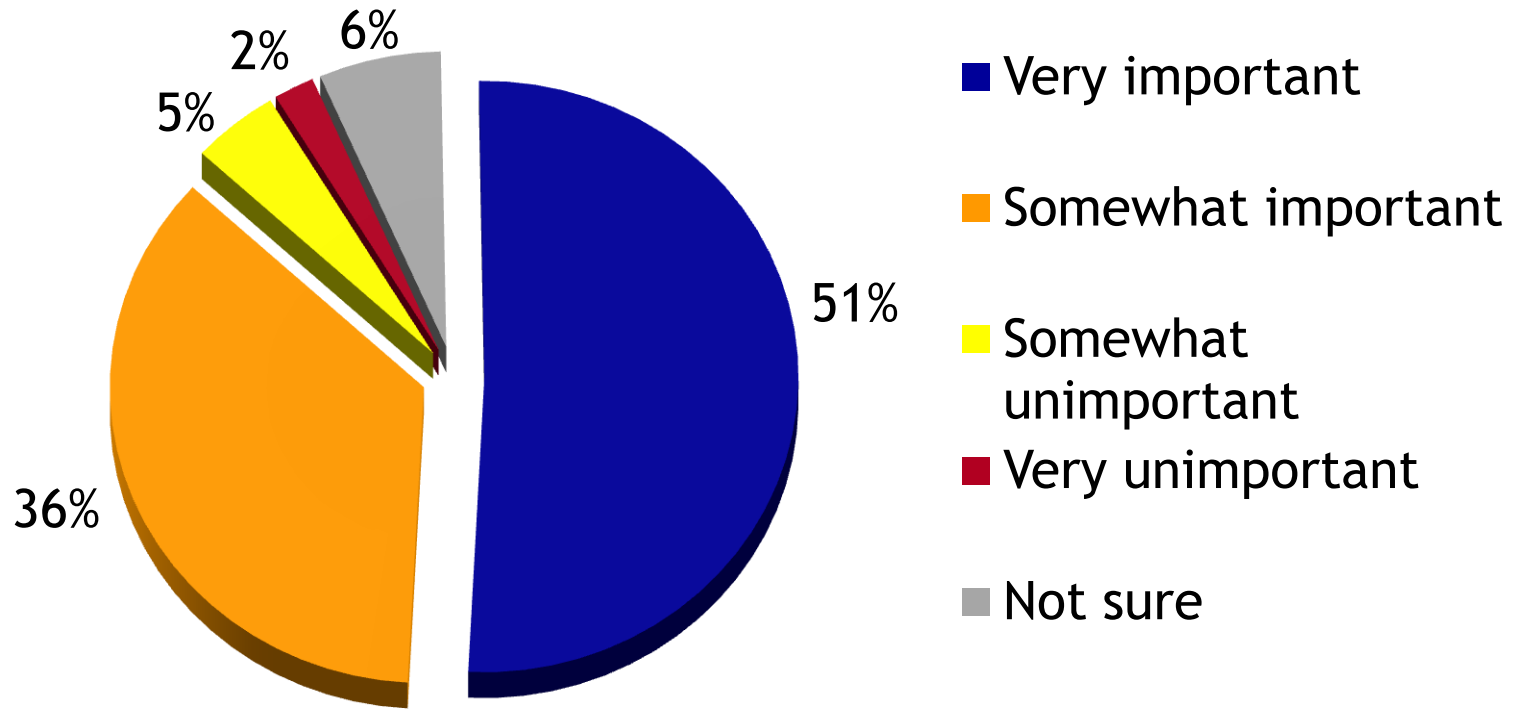

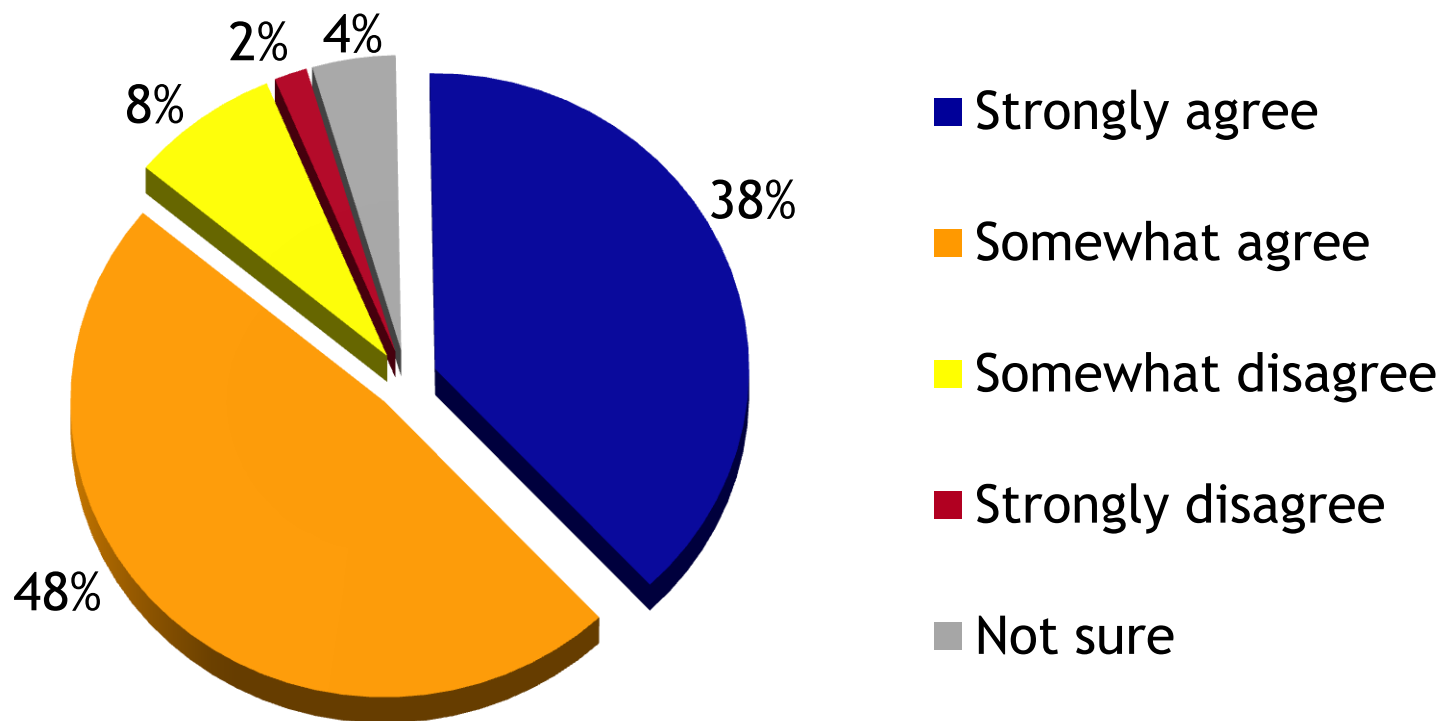
In thinking about threats to your health, how important is it that elected officials at all levels listen to advice from scientists and public health professionals?

Advances in Science Have Been Beneficial, Americans Say

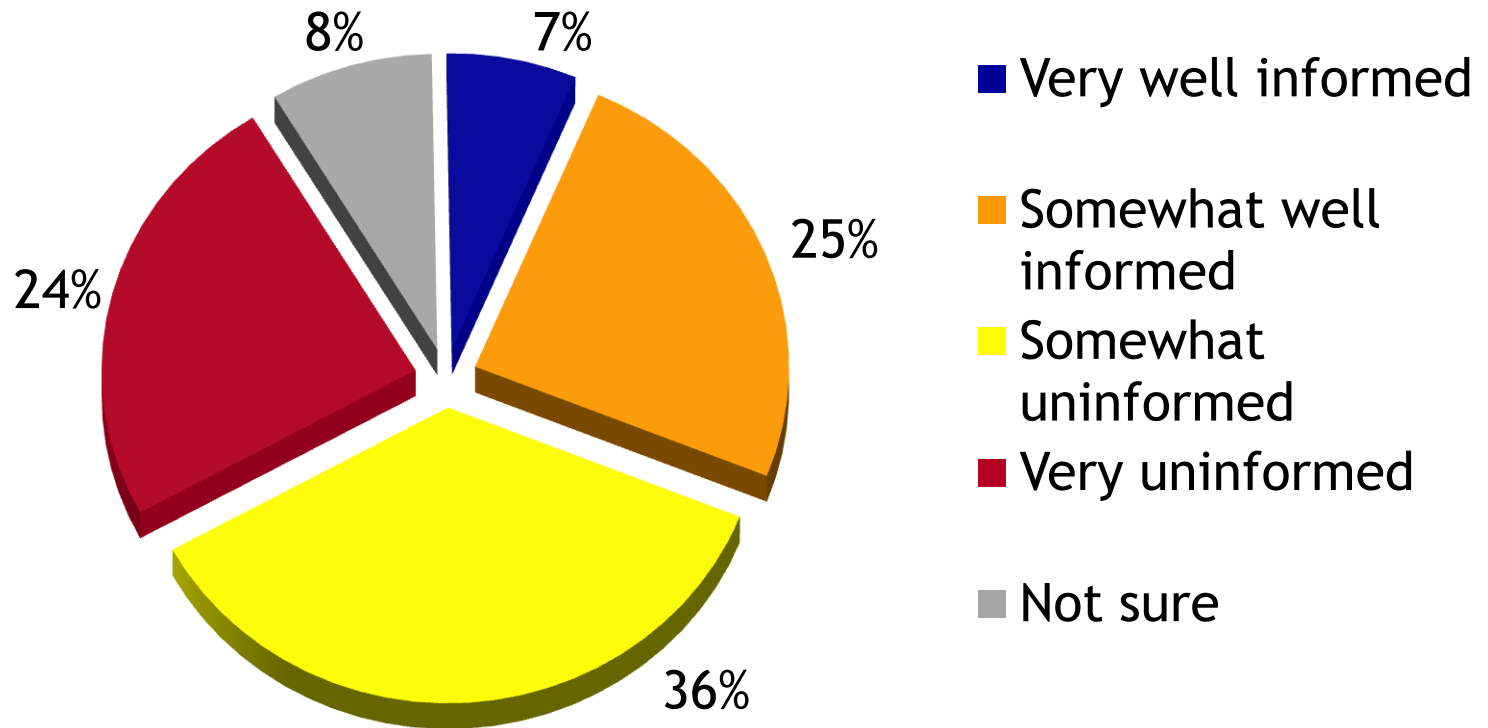
Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? “Overall, advances in science have benefited society and have helped make life easier for most people.”
