### **Survey Methodology**


- Telephone survey of 1,064 U.S. residents age 18 and older
- Conducted: October 1-October 4, 2004
- The survey data were weighted by age, sex, race/ethnicity and geographic region to reflect the demographic composition of the total population of the United States age 18 and older.
- Margin of error <u>+</u> 3% with a 95% confidence interval


Would you say you and your community have benefited from public health services?

Do you know anyone personally who works in a field of public health?





Would you say you and your community benefit from...? (% Saying "Yes")




#### **Americans Don't Know Where Research is Conducted**

#### **Americans' Priorities**


If you had an opportunity to speak with the President of the United States, how high of a priority would you say each of the following is to you and your family? *(% Saying Very High Priority)*


# What Do Americans Think About Abstinence-Only Sex Ed for Teens?


#### Factors Determining High Quality Health Care
