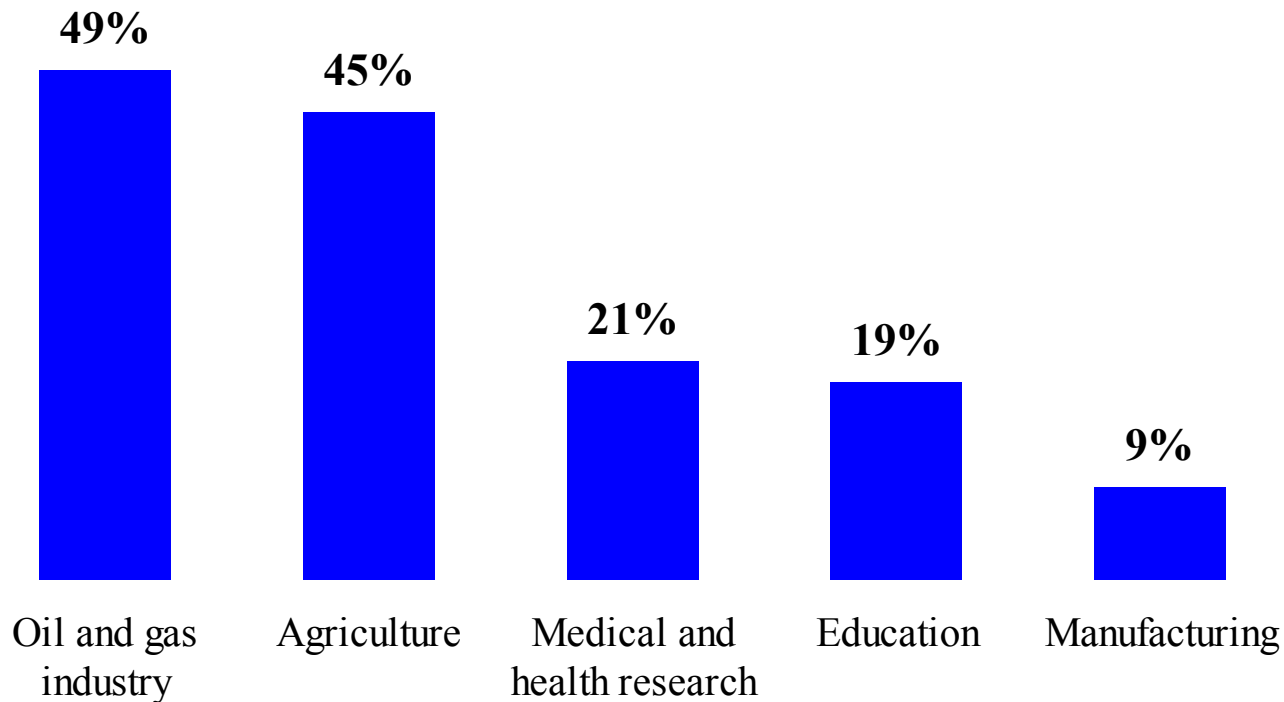

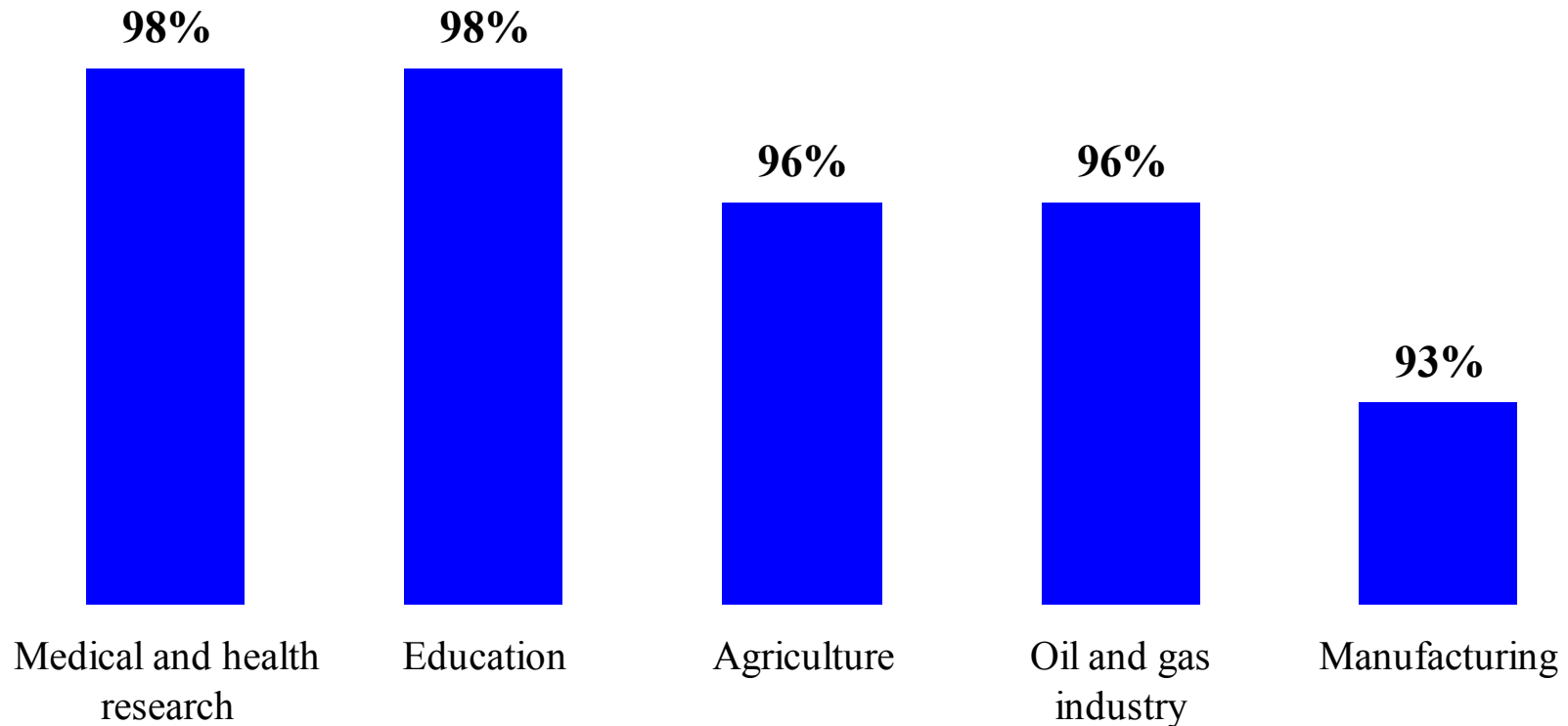
How much of a leader is Oklahoma with regards to the following enterprises?

Important for Oklahoma to Be a Leader

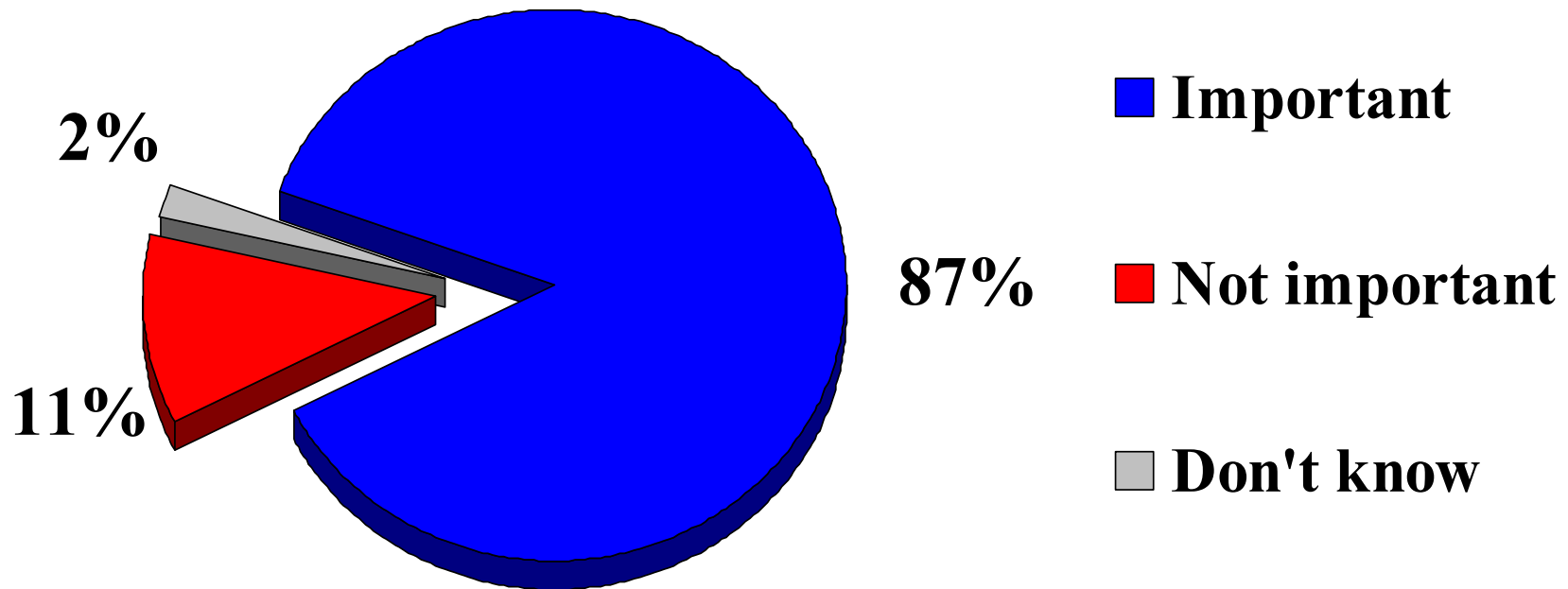
How important is it for Oklahoma to be a leader in the following categories?

Research Important to Oklahoma's Economy

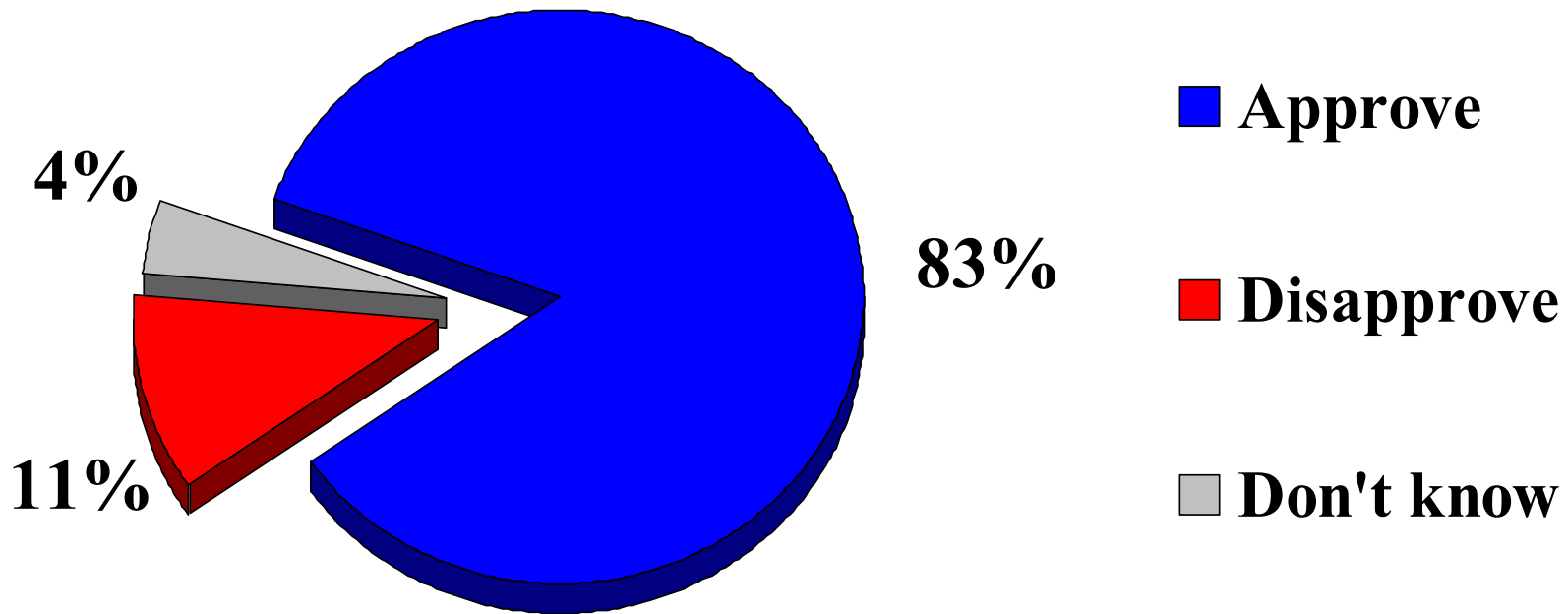
How important do you think scientific research is to Oklahoma's economy?

Oklahomans Approve of Financial Incentives

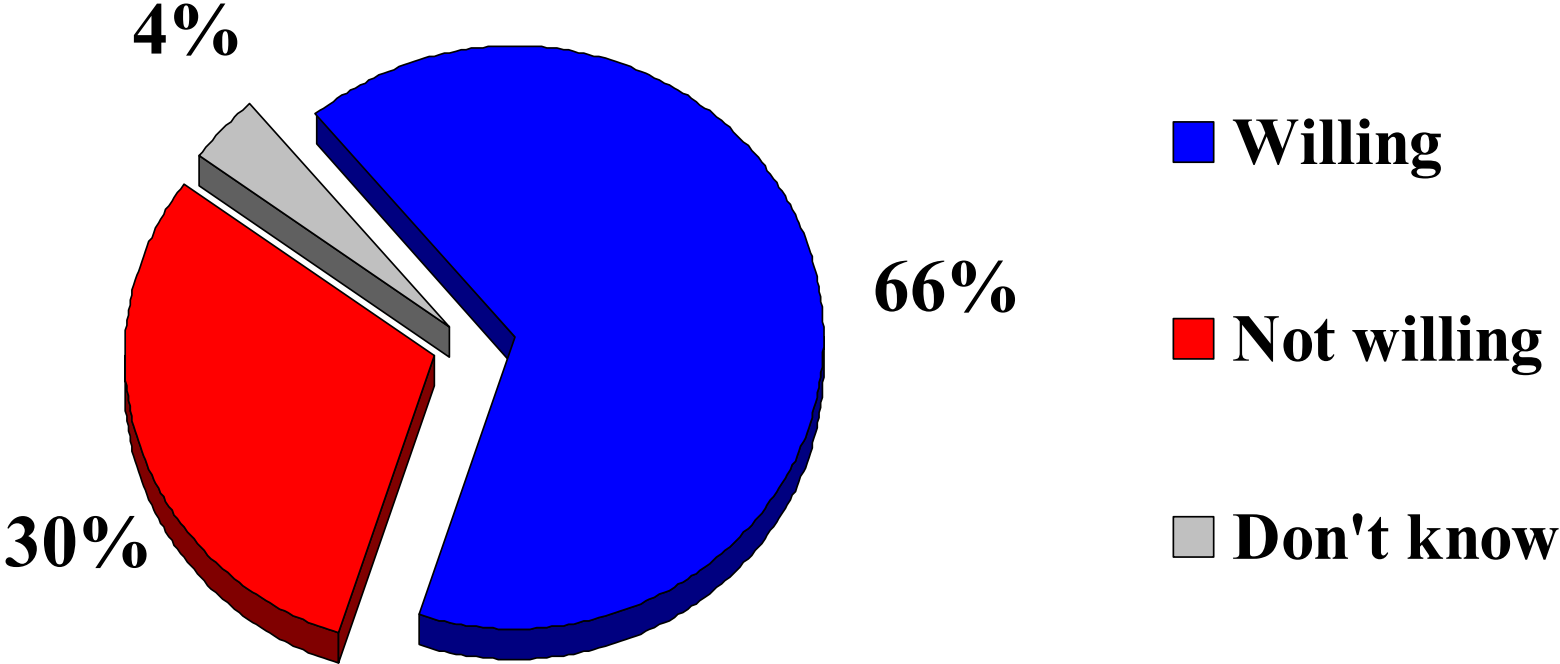
If Oklahoma offered financial incentives to attract new scientific research, such as research labs or companies, would you approve?

Oklahoma Willing to Pay More in Taxes to Fund Medical and Health Research

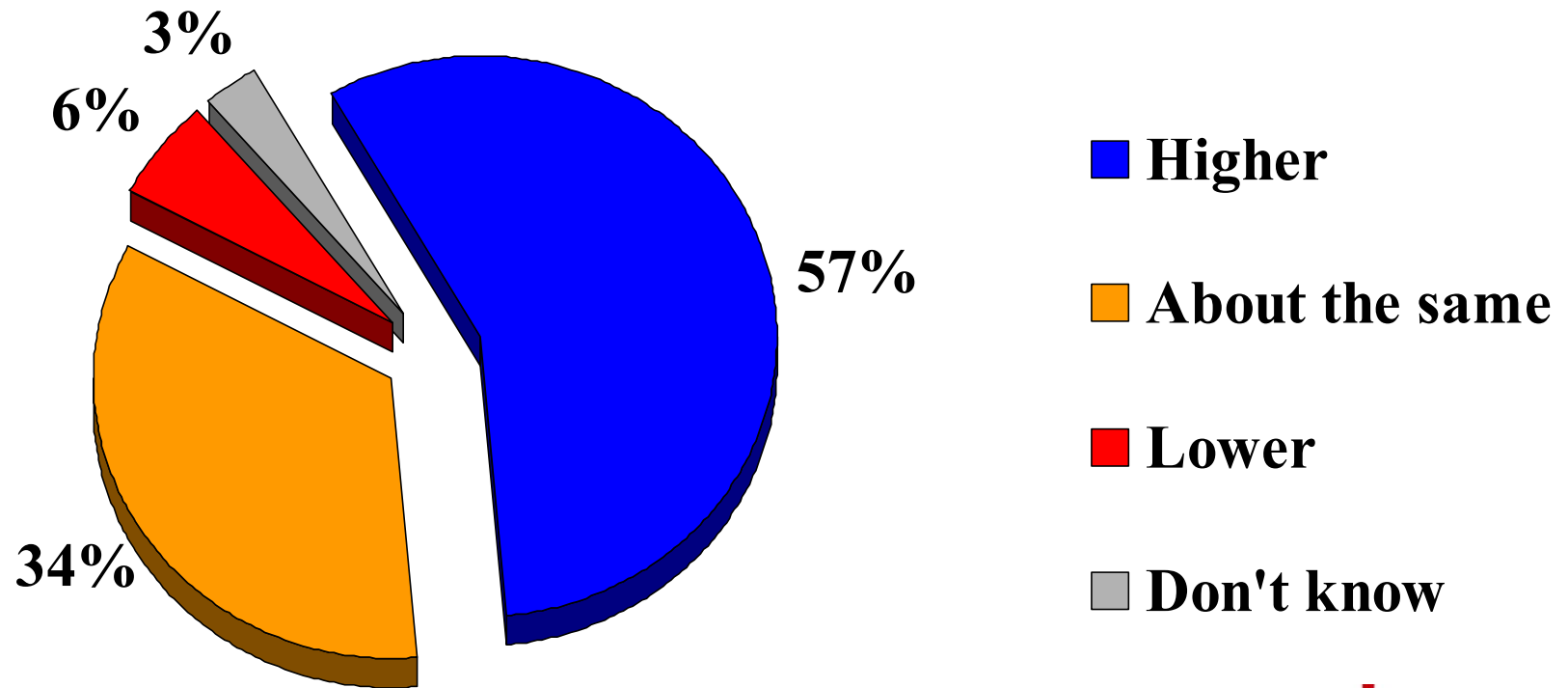
Would you be willing to pay \$1 more per week in taxes if you were certain that all the money would be spent for additional medical and health research?

Oklahomans Think Commitment to Research Should Be Higher

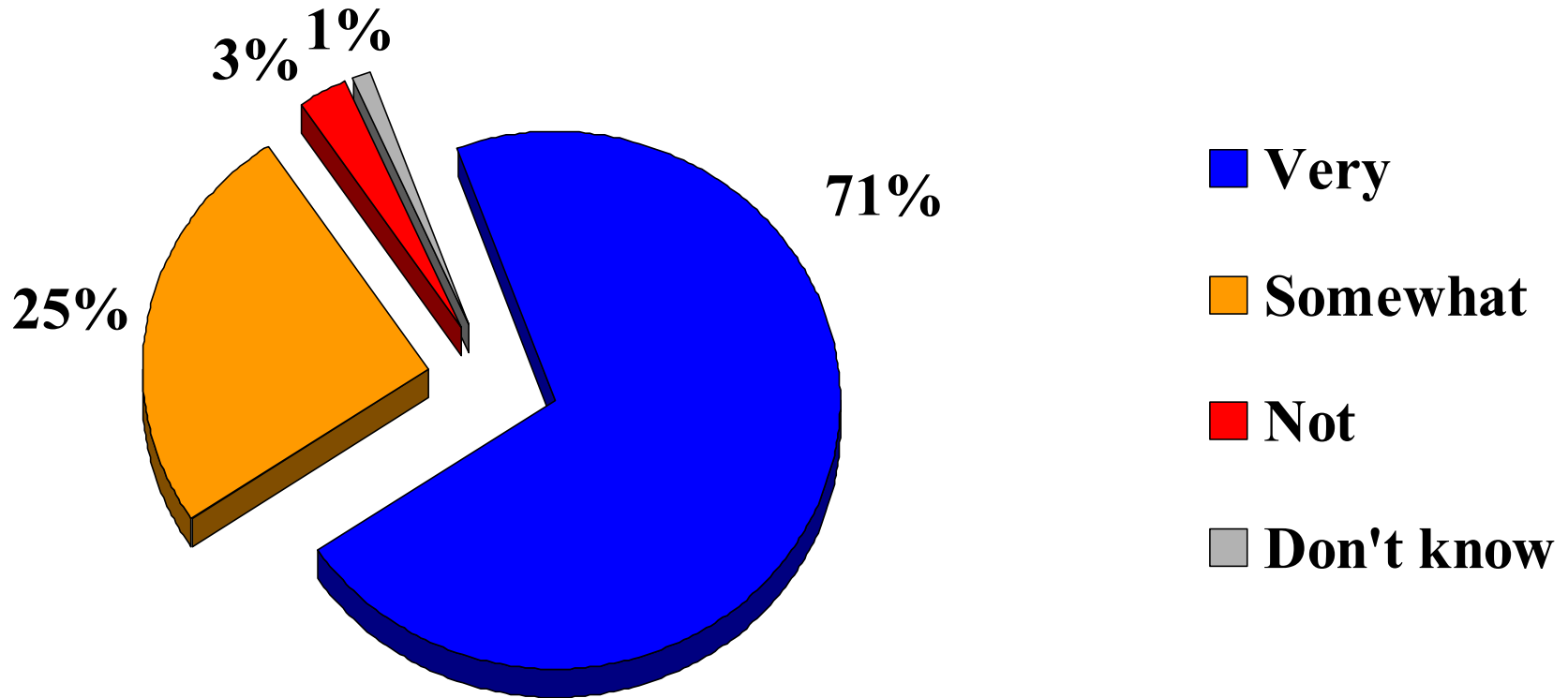
As we look for ways to manage health care costs in our country, do you think that the national commitment to health-related research should be...

How important do you think it is that the U.S. maintains its role as a global leader in medical and health research?

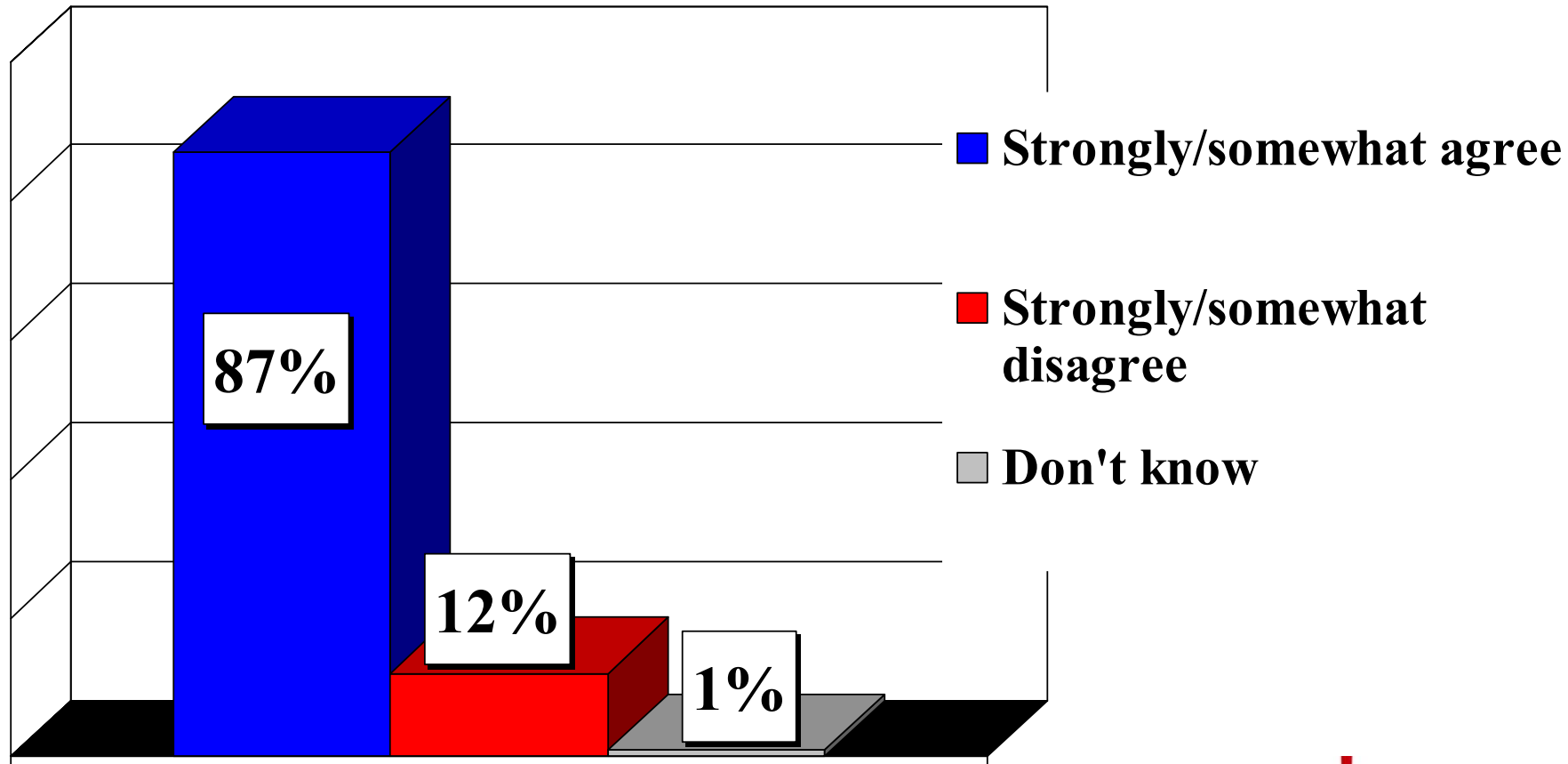

Strong Support for Basic Research

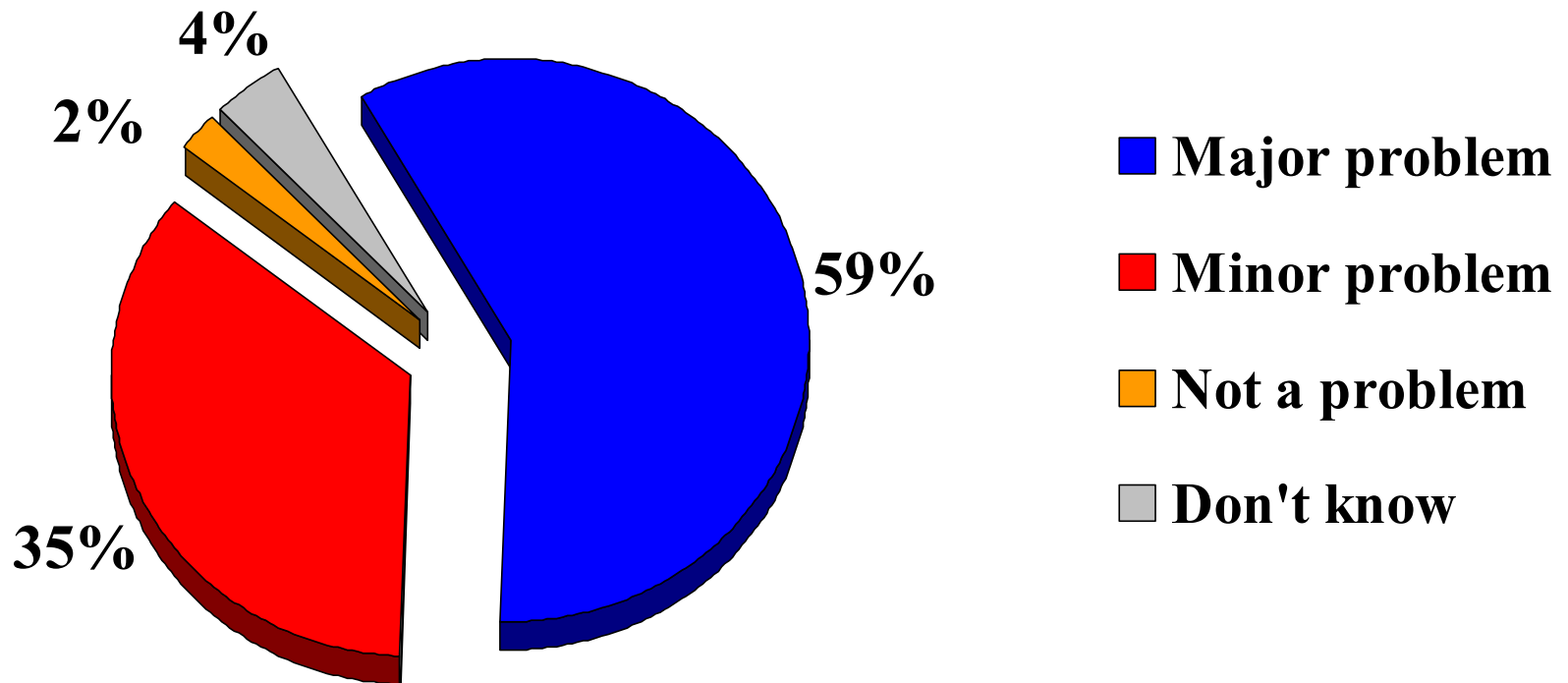
Even if it brings no immediate benefits, basic science research which advances the frontiers of knowledge is necessary and should be supported by the federal government.

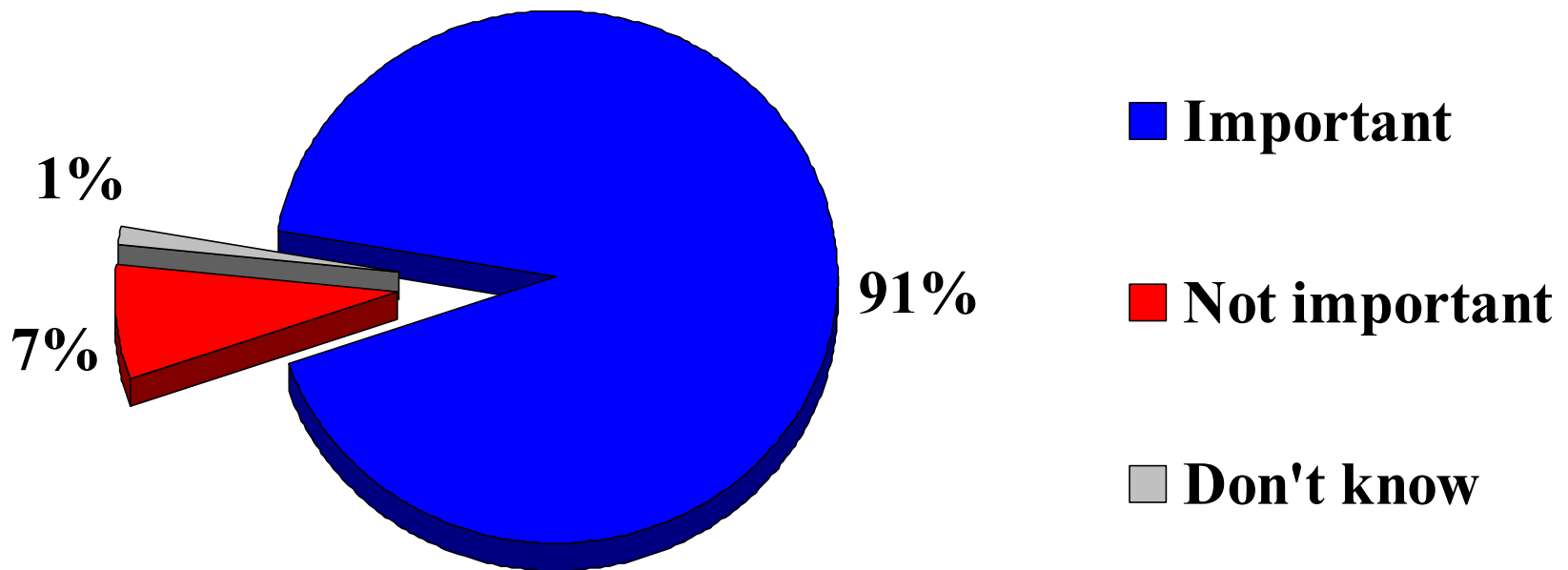
Preventable Diseases Are a Major Health Problem

Important to Eliminate Health Disparities

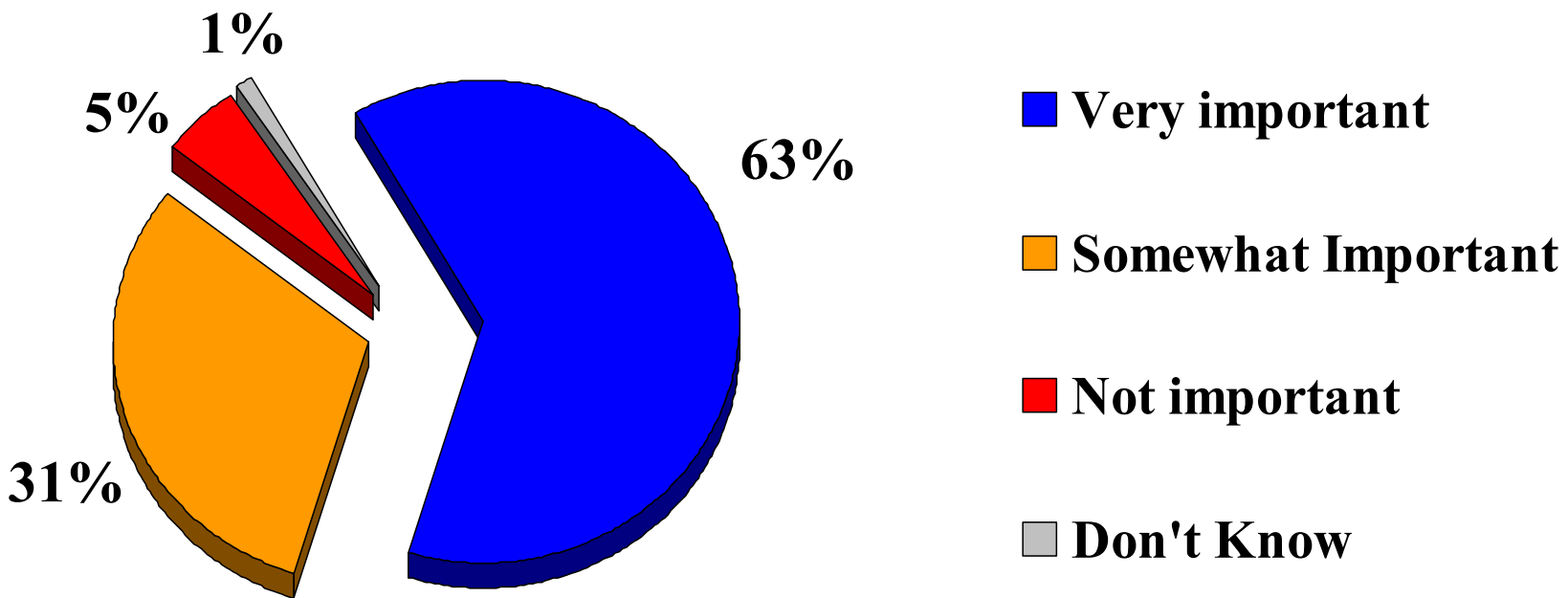

How important is it for the US government to invest in research that helps the CDC to fulfill its mission?

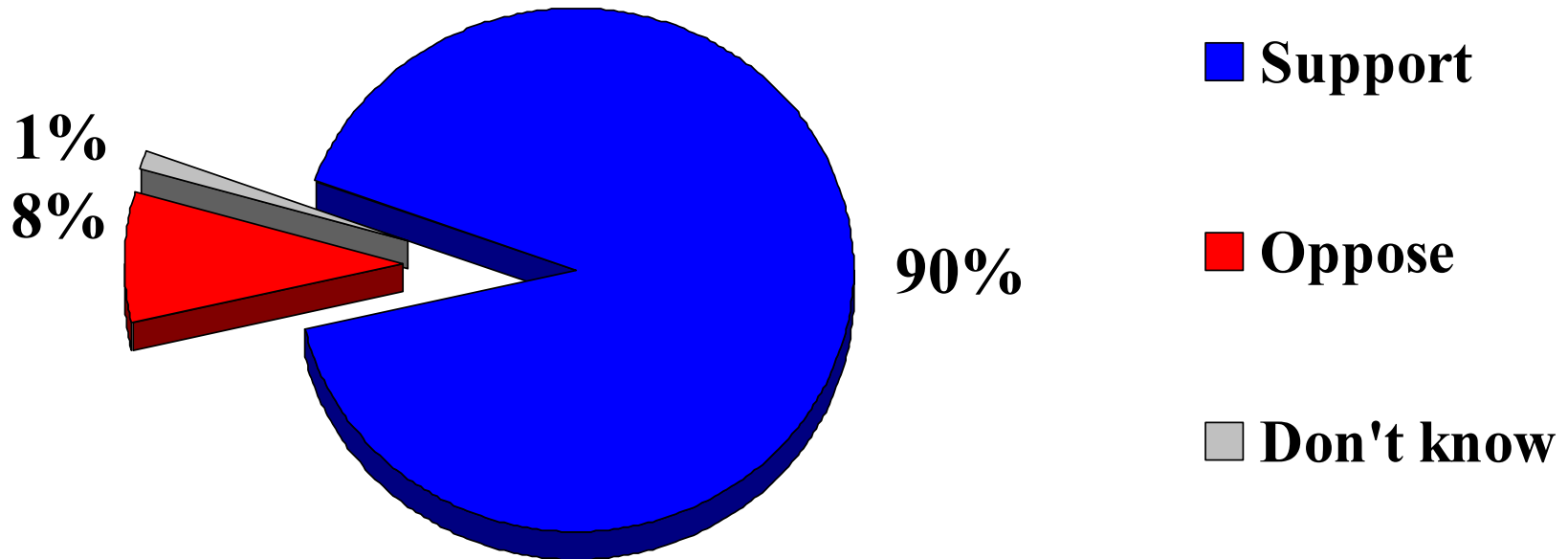

U.S. Should Invest in State and Local Health Departments

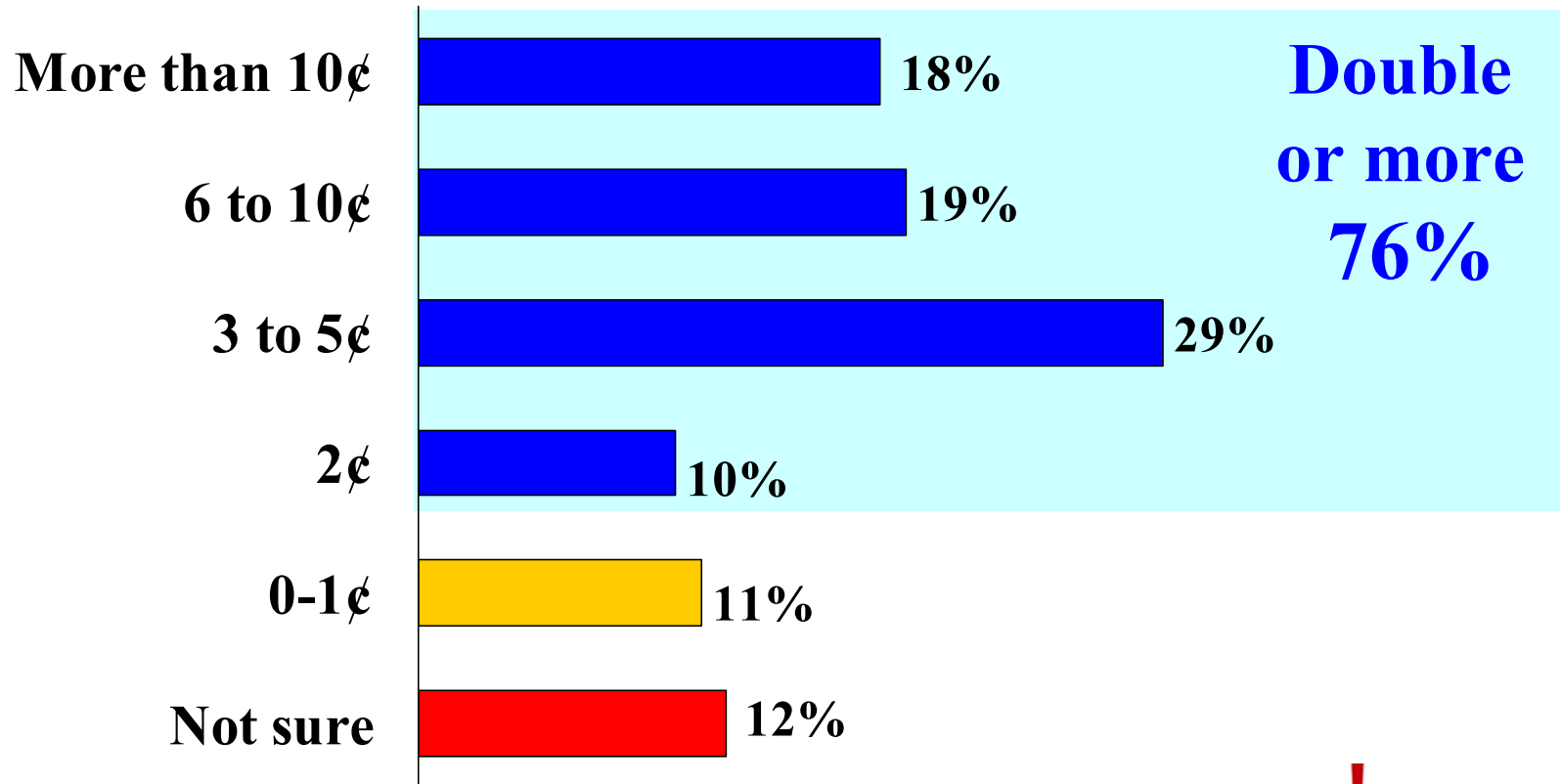
Would you support or oppose increasing federal funding for state and local health departments across the country that are expected to prepare for and respond to threats to our health?

Currently the U.S. Spends about one cent of every health dollar on public health research. How many cents out of each health dollar do you think we SHOULD spend?

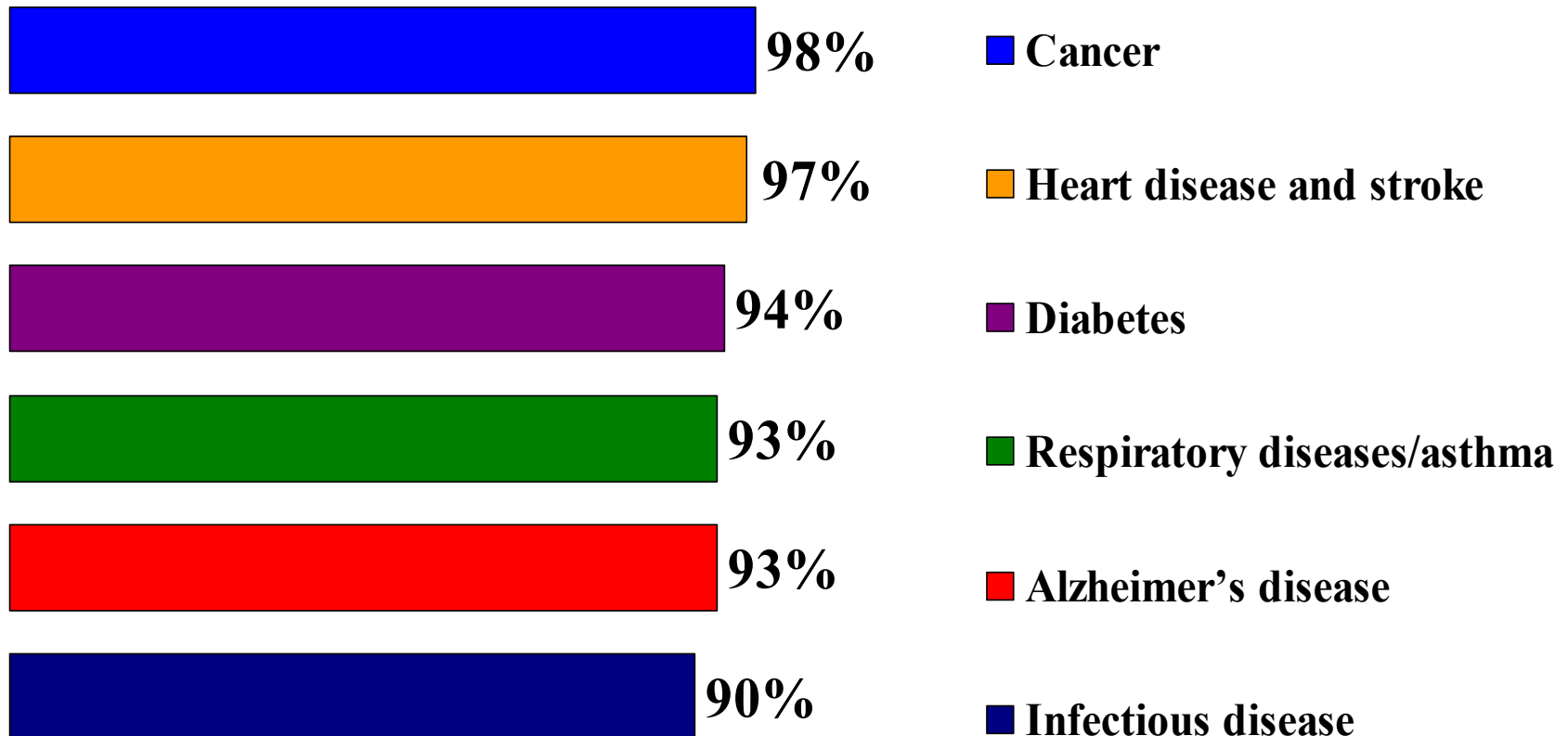

(% Saying top/somewhat high priority)

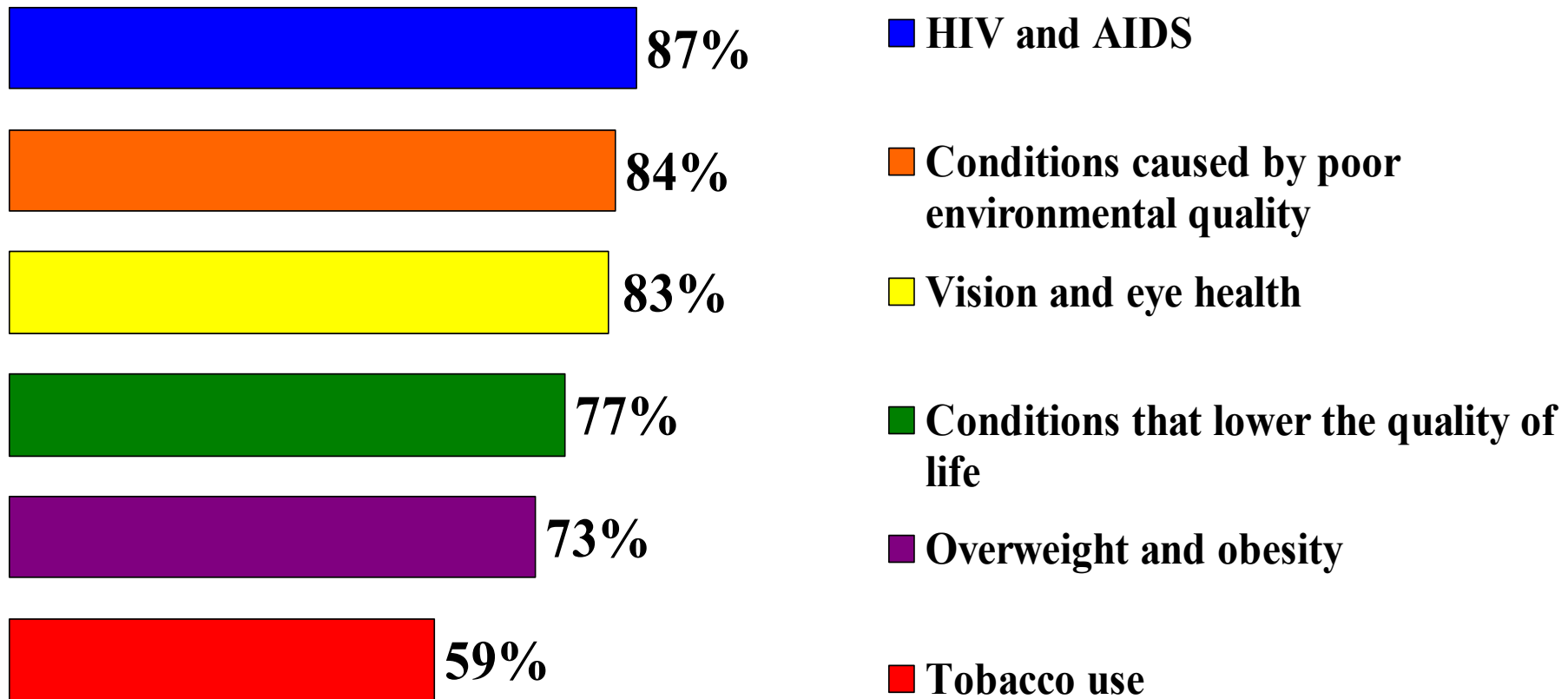

I will read you a list of health problems. In your opinion how much of a priority for Oklahoma should public health research focused on each of these problems be?

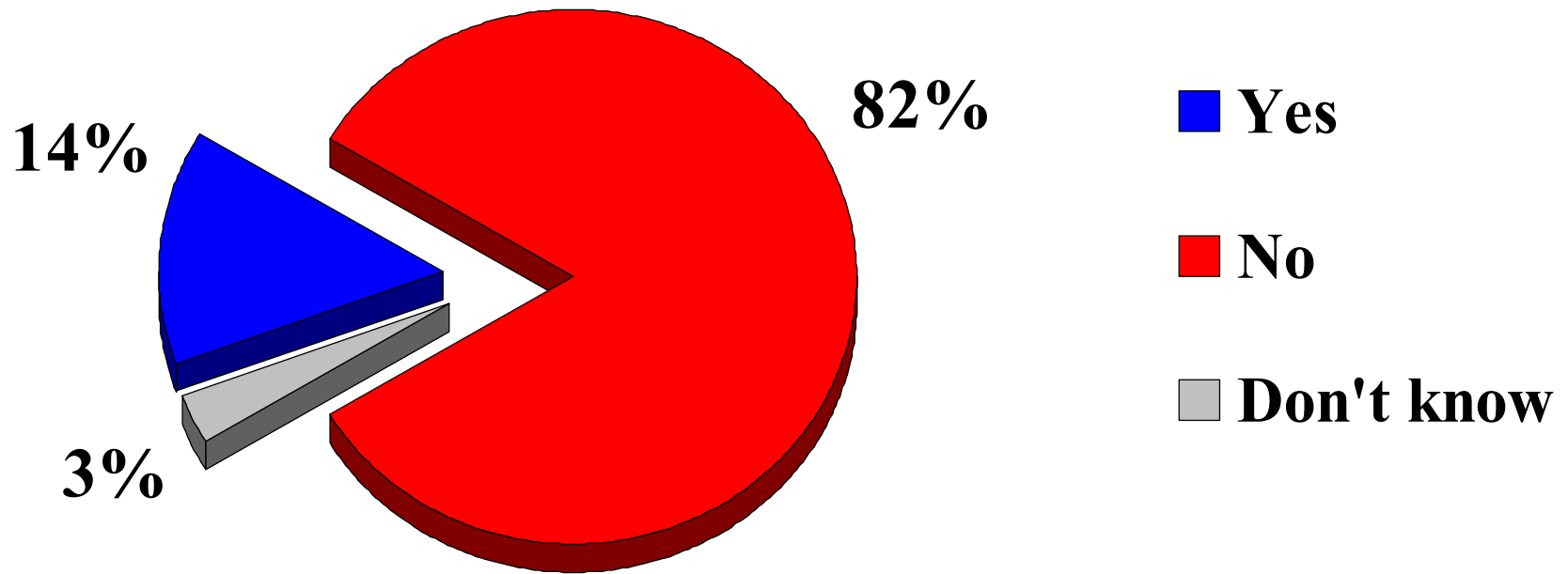
